Purpose: Pursuant to Clients instructions, perform a field survey, break down Section 19 and file a Map of Survey with the Jackson County Surveyor's office, for future surveys within said Section 19.

Procedure: Utilizing a Nikon DTM-522 with a TSC2 Data Collector, and Trimble 5700 RTK GPS unit with a TSC2 Data Collector all found monuments, as depicted hereon, were tied in a closed loop traverse, or by redundant ties.


> Based on said traverse and ties, Surveys Numbered 2656 as filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor, Jackson County Re-established public lands corners and testimonial evidence of original corner locations.

Utilizing the found monuments as shown hereon from the Jackson County Surveyors Re-establishment Notes for the NW. WI/4, SW, SI/4, SE and the E1/4, and the found 1/16 Corner per Survey Number 2656 as shown hereon, a portion of the section could be computed. In order to break down the section completely the NE corner and the NI/4 corner were still needed.

The NI/4 corner has not been re-established by the County Surveyors office, but Road maps from the 1930's and deed records dating to 1915 called for a 3/4-inch Iron pipe at the NI/4. A search was made for this pipe and the pipe was found to be in tact, with the top bent over. There was still enough of the pipe in the ground vertically that an accurate tie could be made by spinning the pipe. This pipe has been replaced as indicated hereon.

Now that the NI/4 corner has been located the only corner in the section needed for a complete break down is the NE corner. In talking and researching at the County Surveyors office it was discovered that the corner had not been re-established or found on any record survey since it was set by Ives and Hyde in 1854. I tied the nearest corners in all directions and calculated a proportionate corner location for a search area. Near this location I found 1.4-foot diameter pine post with a tag marked "Corner Is here, by: Newc, Date: 8-85 for more info call 772-8234". The post has been broken off just below ground level, So the middle of the post was occupied and tied down. This position fit the record well, so I talked to the County Surveyors office. I was told that Tom Newcolm, formerly of the Jackson County Surveyors corner re-establishment crew placed the tag on the post and had good testimonial evidence from Vick Gardener, a long time resident of the area of the corner, that the pine post had been set at the location of the original corner by Herman Meyer in 1915. A pipe was set at the center of the broken off pine post with new accessories as indicated hereon, marking the location of the NE corner of Section 19.


Having all necessary monuments the section break down was computed as shown hereon, with the intent of the ranch for using it to survey individual pieces of property within Section 19 in the future.
