MAP OF SURVEY



LOCATION: THE NORTHEAST AND SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON

PURPOSE: TO SURVEY AND MONUMENT THE CLIENTS PROPERTY BOUNDARY AS DESCRIBED IN INSTRUMENT NUMBER 2006-026643 OF THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON.

BASIS OF BEARINGS: BASIS OF BEARING IS N 0°05'10" W, PER FILED SURVEY NUMBER 9719, BEING FROM THE FOUND 1 1/4" IRON PIPE MONUMENTING THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON, TO THE FOUND 3/4" IRON PIN MONUMENTING THE SOUTH MOST CORNER OF LOT 1, BLOCK 4 OF CLAYTON CREEK MOBIL HOME ESTATES RECORDED IN VOLUME 10, PAGE 32 OF THE PLAT RECORD OF JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON.

PROCEDURE: UTILIZING A TRIMBLE S-6 ROBOTIC TOTAL STATION AND RANGE PRISMS, IN A CLOSED TRAVERSE, I TIE THE MONUMENTS AS SHOWN ON THE ACCOMPANYING PLAT. THE 1 1/4" IRON PIPE MONUMENTING THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25, THE FOUND MONUMENTS ALONG THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF CLAYTON CREEK MOBIL HOME ESTATES AND THE MONUMENT ALONG THE NORTH WESTERLY LINE OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY THAT WAS SET PER FILED SURVEY NUMBER 9719 WERE HELD AS FOUND. THE RECORD RIGHT OF WAY DISTANCE OF 30.00 FEET WAS USED TO SET THE CENTER OF VLEET WAY ALONG THE LINE FROM THE MONUMENT AT THE MOST EASTERLY CORNER OF LOT 1, BLOCK 4 AND THE MONUMENT AT THE MOST EASTERLY CORNER OF LOT 18,

BLOCK 1, BOTH LOTS OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED CLAYTON CREEK MOBILE HOME ESTATES.

DEED RECORD BEARINGS AND DISTANCES IN INSTRUMENT NUMBER 2006-026643 MATCH THOSE SHOWN ON FILED SURVEY NUMBER 9719. THE DEED RECORD BEARING FROM THE FOUND MONUMENT ALONG THE NORTHWESTERLY LINE OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY WAS USED TO INTERSECT THE RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY AND THE RESULTING DISTANCE FIT WELL WITH THE RECORD.

THE ABOVE MENTIONED DEED DOSE NOT CALL THE RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY AS IT COURSES SOUTHEASTERLY. THE CENTER LINE OF THE MAIN LINE TRACKS WAS TIED AND ITS SINUOSITIES COMPARED WELL WITH THE CALCULATED DEED CALLS. AS THE DEED CALLS FOR THE RIGHT OF WAY TO RUN ALONG THE TRACKS THE DEED COURSES WERE HELD AS WRITTEN. THE EXCEPTION BEING THE WIDENING WHICH WAS FOUND TO BE APPROXIMATELY TWO FEET TO FAR NORTH. THIS WAS DETERMINED BY FIXING THE STATIONING AT 900+00 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 25 AND THE TIED CENTER LINE OF THE TRACKS PER 'THE RIGHT OF WAY AND TRACK MAP OF THE MAIN LINE OF THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY', ON FILE AT THE JACKSON COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE. COMPUTING THE CURVES PER SAID MAP, CALCULATING THE STATION AND PROJECTING IT TO THE DEED BOUNDARY AT THE 50 FOOT RIGHT OF WAY RESULTING IN A MORE FAVORABLE FIT TO THE EXISTING CONDITIONS OF THE TRACK. THE DIFFERENCE IN MEASUREMENTS BEING NOTED ON THE ACCOMPANYING PLAT. THIS ALSO FIT THE STATIONING OF TIED IMPROVEMENTS AS SHOWN ALONG THE MAIN LINE ON THE ABOVE MENTIONED RAILROAD MAP.
