

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH CHAPTER 209, PARAGRAPH 250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR: JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON

County Courthouse Rm 318A 10 South Oakdale Avenue

LOCATION: Northeast quarter and Southeast quarter of Section 19, Township

36 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County,

Oregon

PURPOSE: Locate, monument and map the boundaries of land owned by

Jackson County, Oregon

PROCEDURE: Due to the historical significance of this being the site of Fort Lane,

circa 1854, this property was deeded to Jackson County by way of

Document No. 86-05511 of the County Deed Records. The land is within the boundaries of the Townsite of Tolo, the plat of which was recorded in the Plat Records in 1888. The townsite was never developed as such, and a large portion of the plat has been vacated.

The boundary description given in said Doc. No 86-05511 included Tenth Street and a portion of H Street, which remain dedicated for public street purposes. These were included in this survey as being a part of the County ownership, with the street dedications being considered public easements.

Said deed description described the boundary as being along the northerly, westerly, and southerly boundaries of Lots 22, 23, and 24 in Block 30 of the Tolo townsite. This was incorrect in the fact that the adjoining lots, in private ownership, have fee title interest in half of the width of the dedicated 20 ft. alley in Block 30, and in half of the 60 ft. width of dedicated F Street. The alley and the adjoining portion of F Street have been vacated, and therefore this survey reflects the resulting boundaries of said Lots 22, 23 and 24. That also includes the westerly 30 ft. of that portion of 8 the Street that was recently vacated.

Filed Survey No. 119, by C.Z. Boyden in 1949, established the basis of control on which subsequent surveys have relied. The County Surveyor surveyed and monumented the county boundary in 1986, soon after the property was conveyed to Jackson County. That survey is filed as CS 10695. This is basically a retracement of that survey.

During the course of this survey it was determined that the monument set on CS 10695, at the angle point on the exterior boundary at the southwesterly end of

Tenth Street, was set out of position. A new monument has now been established in the correct position, and the previous monument removed.
