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

AFFIDAVIT OF DEFERRED MONUMENTS TO COMPLY WITH 92.070 OF THE OREGON REVISED STATUTES

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, Kerry K. Bradshaw, a duly Registered Land Surveyor of the State of Oregon, do hereby affirm that I have established with proper monuments the subdivision corners depicted as "DEFERRED MONUMENT" on the official plat of GRANITE RIDGE recorded January 22, 2007 in Volume 33 of Plats at Page 6 of Records of Jackson County, Oregon and filed as Survey No. 19488 in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor. The deferred monuments are 5/8 inch x 24 inch rebar with yellow plastic caps stamped "BRADSHAW, LS 2271". Exception to which described as follows:

- 1. The set 5/8 inch x 24 inch rebar monumenting the most northerly-northeast corner of TRACT "A" was destroyed during construction and has been replaced with a brass tack with washer stamped "LS 2271". Said tack and washer is set in a concrete gutter and bears South 03°39'00" East 2.49 feet from the Initial Point of GRANITE RIDGE.
- 2. Set brass tack with washer stamped "LS 2271" in concrete gutter on the northerly line of TRACT "A" at the west end of the curve labeled "C12". Said tack and washer bears South 85°11'36" West 6.70 feet from the most northerly-northeast corner of said TRACT "A".
- 3. Set brass tack with washer stamped "LS 2271" in top of concrete curb on the northerly line of TRACT "A" at the east end of the curve labeled "C2". Said tack and washer bears West 80.71 feet from the tack and washer described in exception number 2 listed above.
- 4. The found 5/8 inch iron pin monumenting the most northerly-northeast corner of GRANITE RIDGE and designated as the Initial Point of said GRANITE RIDGE was destroyed during construction and has been replaced by a 5/8 inch x 30 inch rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "BRADSHAW, LS 2271".
