
Map of Survey

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MONUMENT THE BOUNDARIES OF THAT PARCEL OF LAND DESCRIBED IN JACKSON COUNTY INSTRUMENT NUMBER 95-28105. THE BASIS OF BEARINGS FOR THIS SURVEY WAS THE MEASURED LINE BETWEEN FOUND MONUMENTS ON THE SOUTHERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY OF WILLOW WAY PER C.S. 1325 BY M. BOYDEN AS SHOWN. THE MONUMENTS FOUND WERE HELD UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. THE FIELD WORK WAS COMPLETED IN OCTOBER 2007, UTILIZING A TOPCON GTS 302 TOTAL STATION WITH DATA COLLECTOR AND SUPPORTING EQUIPMENT. RADIAL SURVEY METHODS WITH CROSS CHECKS WERE EMPLOYED.

DURING THE COURSE OF THIS SURVEY, I OBSERVED WHAT APPEARED TO BE SEVERAL STRUCTURES AND A FENCE THAT APPEARED TO LIE VERY CLOSE TO THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN THE SUBJECT PARCEL AND TAX LOT 1300. C.S. 8227 CALLS OUT THE NORTH LINE OF TAX LOT 1300 AS 178.86 FEET WHERE THE DEED (INSTRUMENT No. 03-81900) CALLS FOR 181.25 FEET. BECAUSE OF THIS DISCREPANCY AND THE POSSIBLE ENCROACHMENTS IN THE AREA, A CHAIN OF TITLE WAS RUN TO DETERMINE WHICH PARCEL IS SENIOR. THE CHAIN OF TITLE WAS RUN BACK TO PATENT AND BASED ON THE INFORMATION COLLECTED, THE LOCATION FOR THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE SUBJECT PARCEL AS SHOWN BY GARY KAISER IN C.S. 8227 WAS HELD AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE.
