SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

LOCATION: DLC #47, Sec. 11, T38SR2W, W.M.

PURPOSE: To monument and prepare an official plat of WEST HILLS

SUBDIVISION, UNIT NO. 1.

PROCEDURE:

Traversed from the officially re-established Northeast corner of DLC #48, Westerly to the officially re-established Southwest corner of DLC #47; thence Northerly to the officially re-established South-Southeast corner of DLC #46.

Then enclosed the subject parcel, tying in the T.I.D. Canal, Hartley and Griffin Creeks.

The most-Westerly corner of Parcel 2 described in Volume 496, Pages 43-46 of the Deed Records was located according to the record tie from the Northeast corner of DLC #48.

Meridian was determined by solar observation.
