

PURPOSE: Perform a boundary survey and prepare a Property Line Adjustment pursuant to Client's instructions and as approved by the City of Medford Planning Commission (Case File No. PLA-07-283).

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a Trimble 5-6 robotic instrument and Trimble 5700 Global Positioning System (GPS) with a Trimble TSCe data collector with Trimble software, all found monuments were tied via closed traverses or by redundant ties. Records utilized: Instruments Numbered 98-034719 and 97-039913 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon, Fair Oaks Orchard Tracts (recorded September 15, 1910, in Volume 2 of Plats at Page 50 of the Records of Jackson County, Oregon), and Surveys Numbered 2280, 4570, 6468, 7254, 15866 and 16072 as filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.


Established the centerline of North Phoenix Road utilizing found monuments as depicted hereon, establishing the easterly right of way per Instrument No. 97-39913, being the westerly boundary of the subject tracts. Established the centerline of Barnett Road utilizing found monuments and the computed position of the SE DLC 58 corner per Jackson County Re-Estab Notes as depicted hereon, establishing the northerly right of way per record width, being the southerly boundary of the subject tracts. Established the easterly boundary utilizing the found monument along the southerly right of way of the 40' wide Dedicated Road per SN 7254 and the computed position of said SE DLC 58 corner. Utilizing found monuments per Surveys Numbered 2280, 4570 and 7254, established the centerline of the 40' wide Dedicated Road and the calculated original lots per said Fair Oaks Orchard Tracts, in relation to the established centerlines of North Phoenix Road and Barnett Road. The Tract of land described in Instrument Number 02-58599 was then established utilizing record angles and distances. Both Instruments Numbered 98-34719 and 02-58599 make reference to the center of an un-named creek which no longer exists in this area due to agriculture practices and site grading. The northerly boundaries were then calculated utilizing the established lot lines per Fair Oaks Orchard Tracts, the established tract of land per Instrument No. 02-58599 and record angles and distances per Instrument No. 98-34719. The resultant boundaries were then computed and the corners were set as depicted hereon. The first monument of which was set on May 5, 2008.
