

Northeast and Northwest One-Quarter Section 32, Township 35 South, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose:

To survey and mark with monuments the boundary of the lands described within document No. 2007-028011, deed records of Jackson County Oregon and to partition said land into two parcels according to my client's direction and approved Planning Action SUB 2007-00073 Jackson County Planning Department.

Procedure:

I began with the recovery of my survey control established during filed survey No 19676. Oregon State Highway Department Map 2B22-9, Jackson County Surveyor file Roll Map No 97-7 (circa 1930 asconstructed map) was utilized to control the right of way of Mill Creek Drive. The existing traveled center line was tied and an attempt was made to correlate the existing alignment with the 1930 record. Although the alignments are similar I was unable to recover alignment monuments or points adequate to determine the right of way line. I established witness corner monuments using the existing traveled alignment as control.

I determined a transposition in the beginning bearing utilized in the Oregon Highway Department referenced map. The bearing is shown as South 1° 16' East and should probably should be South 1° 16' West. I determined this bearing to be closer to South 1° 50' West.

The bearing of the south right of way line of Red Blanket Road (County Road) was extended west to the computed intersection of the right of way lines.
