Dear Mr. Baughman,

Am returning your survey because of deficientcies and errors. We noted differences in the bearings and disntances to bearing trees at the SW corner of DLC #52 and the NE Corner of DLC #53 between your submitted survey and the County Surveyor's corner Re-establishment records, not knowing which record was correct, our office made a field check and found the County Surveyor's Records to be substantially correct. Your survey should be revised to reflect the correct present-day data so that confusion will be kept to a minimum at these corners for future use of surveyors and property owners.

The next item that should be corrected is the narrative which should be typed on tracing paper backed with smudge-proof carbon, stamped and signed.

One other item that wight affect the positioning of the property lines is the location of the North boundary of DLC #53.

The County Surveyor's corner re-establishment records indicates no re-establishment data for the Northwest corner of DLC #53, but re-establishments from local evidence for the SW and SE corners of DLC #52 and the NE corner of DLC #53.

You will note in the Original Government Record for DLCs 52 and 53 that the claims run to and call for corners of adjoining claims. Assuming that your survey requires the north line or DLC #53, a search should be made for the NW corner of DLC #53. If all evidence of this corner is lost, then the north line of DLC #53 would be a straight line from the SW corner to the SE corner of DLC #52, thence Easterly to the NE corner of DLC #53.
