
Map of Survey

PURPOSE

TO SURVEY AND MONUMENT THE PARCEL OF LAND DESCRIBED IN DOCUMENT NO. 03-17355 OF THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON.

NARRATIVE


A NIKON DTM 522 TOTAL STATION AND CARLSON DATA COLLECTOR WERE USED TO TIE FOUND CENTERLINE MONUMENTS AND MONUMENTS PER FILED SURVEY NO. 16030 IN A CONTROL TRAVERSE. THE RIGHT—OF—WAY LINES AND BLOCKS WERE DETERMINED USING SAID FOUND CENTERLINE MONUMENTS AND RECORD INFORMATION PER FILED SURVEYS 16030, 1285, 433 AND THE PLAT OF CENTRAL POINT. THE SUBJECT BLOCK WAS THEN DIVIDED INTO LOTS 1, 2, 3, AND 4 USING THE PORPORTIONATE METHOD. THE NORTHWESTERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF THE ALLEY WAS HELD PARALLEL TO THE SOUTHEASTERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF ALDER STREET, THEREFORE HOLDING THE PORPORTIONATE DISTANCE OF 140.57 FOR THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF BLOCK 37. SINCE BLOCK 37 IS A PARTIAL BLOCK THIS WOULD BE THE BEST PROCEDURE FOR THIS SURVEY. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THE PLAT OF CENTRAL POINT DOES THIS SURVEY. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THE PLAT OF CENTRAL POINT DOES NOT SHOW THE BLOCK BEING BROKEN INTO LOTS, ALTHOUGH THE PROPERTIES ARE DESCRIBED AS "LOT #, BLOCK 37, THE ORIGINAL TOWNSITE, OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL POINT, JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON". FURTHER RESEARCH BETWEEN LOCAL TITLE COMPANIES AND THE CITY OF CENTRAL POINT WAS UNSUCCESSFUL IN LOCATING A PLAT SHOWING BLOCK 37 BEING DIVIDED INTO LOTS. THE ASSESSOR'S OFFICE ALSO SHOWS THE BLOCK BEING LOTTED OUT AS SHOWN. IN CONVERSATIONS WITH THE ASSESSOR'S OFFICE IT IS BELIEVED THAT THERE ARE MANY HAND COPIED VERSIONS OF THIS PLAT THAT MAY HAVE SOME DISCREPENCIES BETWEEN THEM. HOWEVER THESE LOTS WERE SOLD USING THE AFOREMENTIONED PROPERTY DESCRIPTIONS. LAWYERS TITLE CONFIRMED THEY WOULD INSURE THE PROPERTIES USING THESE DESCRIPTIONS. THEREFORE IT WAS DECIDED TO SURVEY THE SUBJECT BLOCK AND PARCEL AS SHOWN UTILIZING THIS INFORMATION.
