Survey Narrative to Comply with Oregon Revised Statutes, Paragraph 209.250

The Decarlo property is described as a portion of the original lot 8 of Valley View Addition to the Town of Jacksonville subdivision.

The adjacent lots to the West and North were created during Woodberry Subdivision, and are known as lots 2 and 5.

The south boundary of Valley View Addition to the Town of Jacksonville and Woodberry Subdivision, and the north boundary of Gold Mine Subdivision Unit No.1, do not share a common boundary. A strip of land, sixteen feet wide, more or less, exists between the subdivisions north of Welcum Lane and Gold Mine Subdivision unit No. 1. This strip, known as current tax lot 3890, was acquired by Jackson County through tax foreclosure recorded as document 87-00548, Official Records of Jackson County. In addition to tax lot 3890, Jackson County also listed tax lot 37-2W-29C-3900, adjacent and westerly of tax lot 3890. There is no record of road dedication for public use.

Welcum Lane, a private road, crosses private land and County land. Easements of record indicate access is along a 10 foot strip of land along the southern boundary of Woodberry Subdivision and Valley View Addition Subdivision. The existing roadway is not contained within the easement limits.

The existing drainage ditch and associated culverts, for the most part, are located on tax lot 3890, or County property.

I tied to found monuments as shown on the Map of Survey using both RTK GPS and an Electronic Total Station. For the most part, monuments found and shown on Woodberry Subdivision were verified and held for control.

At the Northeast corner of the Decarlo property, I found a 5/8-inch iron pin.

At the Southeast corner of the Decarlo property, I found an unrecorded 5/8-inch iron pin. This corner point is located in Welcum Lane. I set a witness point 10 feet northerly of said corner point, on the northerly line of easements 67-01373 and 95-15846.

At the Southwest corner of the Decarlo property, I found a 5/8-inch iron pin, severely bent to the Northeast. The Decarlo fence is thirteen feet too far to the East near this corner point. This corner point is located in Welcum Lane. I set a witness point 10 feet northerly of said corner point, on the northerly line of easements 67-01373 and 95-15846.

At the Northwest corner of the Decarlo property, I did not find a monument. This corner position is adjacent to a fence post. I set a new monument as shown.

The Right-of-Way for Woodberry adjacent to the Decarlo property is 60 feet..

GPS control was established utilizing the Leica SmartStation duel frequency Real Time Kinematic (RTK) GPS adjusted utilizing Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) GPS network solutions.

BASIS OF BEARING: Geodetic from GPS between control points GPS 1 and GPS 2.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this survey is to identify the Decarlo property as described in document No. 2007-015934, Jackson County Official Records.

HISTORY OF SURVEYS: The history of surveys of T.37 S., R.2 W. pertaining to this survey is as follows:

Donation Land Claim No. 37 (James Clugage Claim) was surveyed by Sewel Truax on September 25, 1855.

Valley View Addition to the Town of Jacksonville was surveyed by G. Elksnat on October 3, 1891.

First Addition to Jacksonville Cemetery by W.H. Wood on March 25, 1932.

Gold Mine Subdivision Unit No. 1 was surveyed by J.A. Hoffbuhr on December 15, 1967.

Woodberry Subdivision was surveyed by Verlyn Thomas on February 10, 1969.

A Property Line Adjustment survey was conducted by Gary D. Kaiser for Lots 3 and 4 of Gold Mine Subdivision Unit No. 1 on July 16, 2002. Refer to recorded survey C.S. 17421.

No other surveys pertinent to this current survey are of record.

PROCEDURE:

Prior to commencement of this survey, deed records of the Decarlo property as well as the adjacent properties were evaluated. Surveys of Record were also evaluated.
