BASIS OF BEARING: Solar Observation.

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

Sec. 1, Township 37 South, Range 1 West.

This survey is a partial retracement of Survey No. 215, recorded in the County Surveyors Office.

Found hubs or nails set on previous survey No. 215.

S. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. Set wood hub in rockmound from which I found

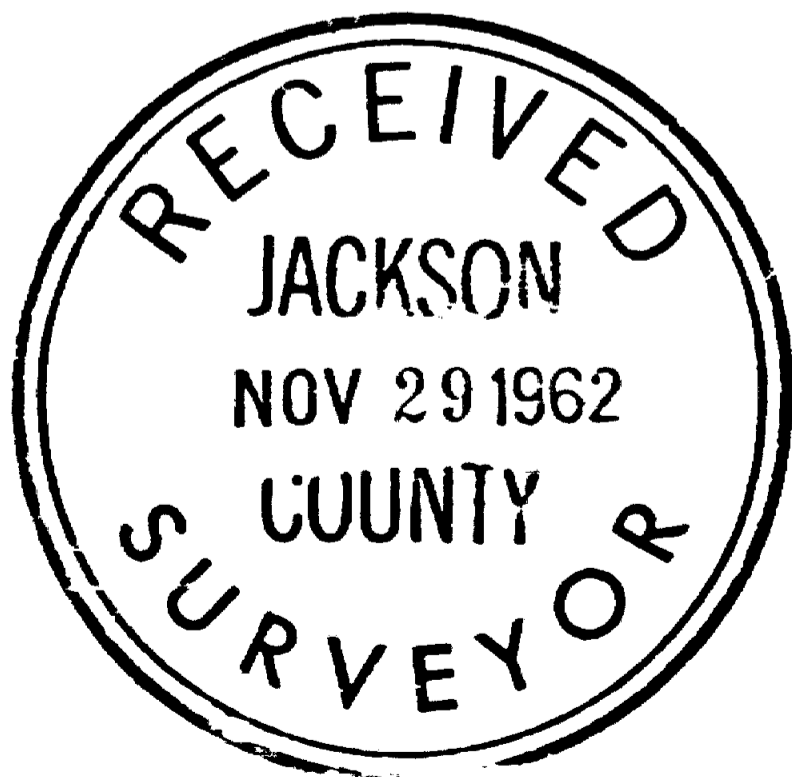
Down white oak snag BT. with two blazes to the SE. and a down and partial burned Pine BT. to the NE., also from which the

Face of doubled blazed forked White oak, 18" diam., bears S.27°E., 86.3 ft.

Face of a double blazed white oak, 8" diam., bears N.69 $\frac{3}{4}$ °E. 133.6 ft.

W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. Set a $\frac{5}{8}$ in. iron pin, 24 in. long, 8 in. deep to bed rock in a rock mound, 24 in. base, 18 in. high. Original BT. old blaze visible, bears N.5°W., 108.90 feet. Corner falls on wind row of rocks where old fence had previously existed, running westerly and line projected northerly would interest now existing fence.

N. & E $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. Found 1 in. iron pipe as per re-estab. records. The east line of Sec. 1 was previously determined in County Survey No. 2038.
