

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

Located in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

A four lot subdivision of this tract was approved by Jackson County under a Measure 37 claim in 2007. In November of that year, Oregon voters approved Measure 49 which modified Measure 37. The Measure 37 claimants who had not yet received State approval were assured that their claims would be quickly reviewed and approved or denied based on Measure 49 criteria. The client recently received notice that their claim would not be resolved until at least June of 2010. I delayed filing a Map of Survey based on the promise of a "quick review". I am filing this map to conform with State law.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

The east - west centerline of Section 24, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon, between the West Quarter Corner and the West Sixteenth Corner as shown on Bureau of Land Management Dependent, Resurvey dated January 15, 1999.

PROCEDURE:

The parent tract of this proposed subdivision is described as the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, excepting two parcels which are described by metes and bounds with calls to set iron pins and pipes. I was able to find the iron pins called for along the boundary of the parcel southeasterly of the parent tract but was unsuccessful in finding the iron pipes along the boundary of the parcel which lies in the southwest corner of the sixteenth section. To reestablish these monuments, I held record distances where applicable and record angles at the two northerly corners. Bishop Creek Road crosses the southerly portion of the parent tract. I was unable to find a recorded public easement for the road although a private easement was granted in Document No. 73-1184 for access to certain properties to the east.
