SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR: Northlight Community Builders, LLC

230 Wilson Road Ashland, Oregon 97520

LOCATION: The Northwest Quarter of Section 9 in Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the

Willamette Meridian, in the City of Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To survey and monument a proposed future subdivision of Parcel 2, Partition Plat

No. P-98-1990 and Tempco Mall Condominium (vacated), said tracts of land also described within Instrument No.'s 2005-050398 and 2007-010426 of the

Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a Leica TCRP 1203 robotic electronic total station and ranging prisms,

in conjunction with survey control previously established by this office during the performance of Survey No.'s 19206 & 19409, on file in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor, I survey the lands formerly known as Copeland Lumber Yard and Tempco Mall Condominium. The boundary of the subject tract is all of Parcel 2, Partition Plat No. P-98-1990, filed as Survey No. 12197, as well as all of Tempco Mall Condominium, (Survey No. 9807), having been vacated as described within Instrument No. 2005-050396 of the Official Records of Jackson County. The majority of boundary monuments shown on said surveys were recovered as shown and held for position or line, except as otherwise shown. The right of way for Lithia Way was previously determined during the performance of Survey No. 19206 by this office. The centerline intersection of First Street and "B" Street was determined by holding the record plat distance of 47.80 feet shown on Survey No. 19206, running westerly along the centerline of "B" Street from it's intersection with the East line of Donation Land Claim No. 40. From that intersection, I calculated a line running southerly at a 19.00 foot perpendicular offset from a recovered 1" diameter iron axle at the northeast corner of Tempco Mall Condominium, held by both surveyors Mark Boyden and Everett Swain, which matched the bearing of South 15°50'24" West used by Swain on Survey No. 12197, and projected this bearing to intersect the northerly line of "C" Street. This intersection point matched extremely well with record distances along said northerly line of "C" Street to found monuments shown on said described Survey's 9807 & 12197. The only monument recovered along the exterior boundary of this survey which was not held for position was a 1/2" iron
