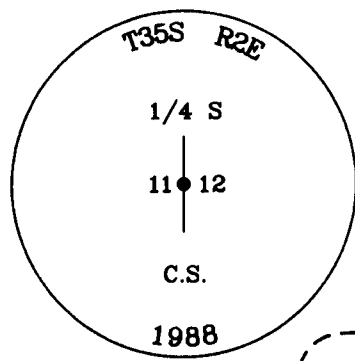
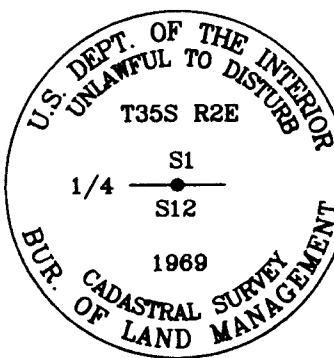


FD. 1" PIPE WITH 2-1/2" BRASS,

BRASS CAP MARKED:



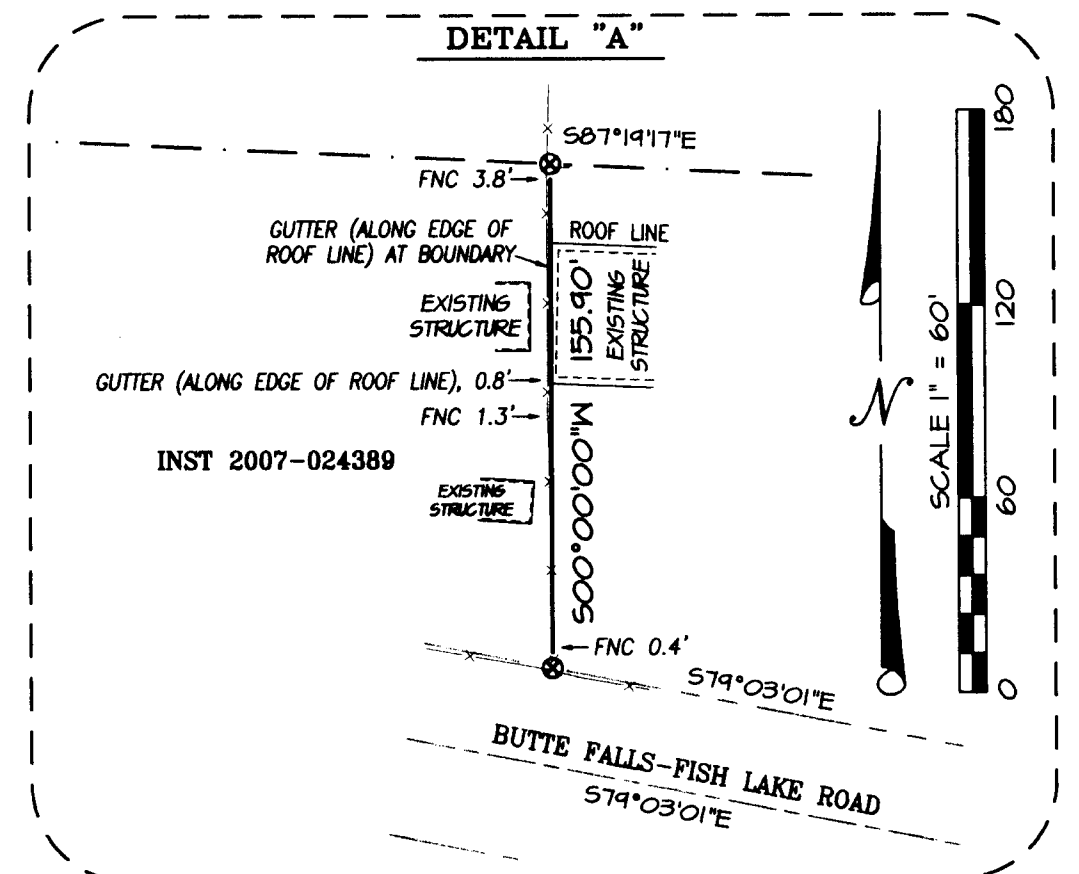
MAP OF SURVEY

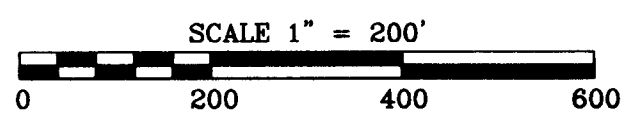

LOCATION:

Located in the Southeast One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter of Section 12, Township 35 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE OF SURVEY:

Pursuant to Client's instructions, perform a boundary survey, establish monuments to signify the location of the east deed line, and to prepare and process a Map of Survey and file same with Jackson County.

SURVEY PROCEDURE:

Utilizing a Trimble 5700 Global Positioning System (GPS), a Trimble S-6 robotic instrument and Trimble TSC2 data collectors with Trimble Survey Controller software, all found monuments were tied via closed traverses or by redundant ties. Records utilized: Instrument Number 2007-024389 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon; a Dependent Resurvey, Subdivision of Sections and Remonumentation survey performed by Bureau of Land Management (BLM), having an accepted date of January 31, 1977); Butte Falls-Fish Lake Road survey performed by county engineer Robert J. Carstensen, dated September 1960, (being referenced as Roll Map Number 6/9), and Re-establishment notes for the One-quarter corner common to Sections 11 and 12, both on file in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.

Located and tied the North, South and East One-quarter corners and the Southwest corner of Section 12 established by said BLM survey, and the West One-quarter corner of Section 12 per said county re-establishment notes. From which, utilized PLSS methods to compute the Southeast One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter of Section 12.

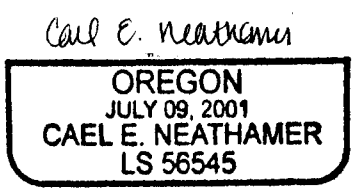
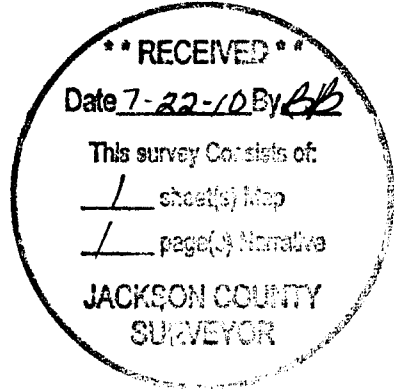
Established the location of the Butte Falls-Fish Lake Road utilizing Roll Map Number 6/9 record data, holding the tied location for the Southwest corner of Section 12, and rotating said map counterclockwise 00°00'51" to match the measured bearing between said tied Southwest and South One-quarter corners of Section 12. From which, a field search for centerline point of intersection monuments and/or their accessories were performed at centerline stations 98+91.00 and 112+70.74, resulting in not finding any evidence. An additional search resulted in finding a 5/8-inch rebar at centerline station 124+63.63 (record: 124+64.34).

Utilizing the resolutions described herein and said Instrument Number 2007-024389, computed the easterly boundary of the Client's property and established monuments on July 1, 2010, as depicted on the accompanying map.

Geodetic North based on the NAD83 (CORS 96) (Epoch 2002.0000) datum, utilizing GPS equipment and solution sets from OPUS (Online Positioning User Service), from the National Geodetic Survey website. Basis applied to the south line of Section 12, as depicted on the accompanying map.
