



Survey narrative to comply with ORS 209.250 .

At request of: Guy F. Hays, 623 North Central, Medford, Oregon

Purpose: To mark the boundaries of Tracts "A" & "B" shown on map, descriptions furnished which do not close by coordinates.

Procedure: Began survey at the corner common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12, a bronze disc with the section numbers stamped, and dated 1960. From this corner I ran a random line South and tied in to the Quarter corner common to Sections 11 and 12. For this corner I found old 3" + 3" stake scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  on one face, this stake rotted at base and weathered, <sup>S</sup> this stake wired to a 5/8" iron bolt in stone mound, ~~S~~ B.Ts. in evidence. the bearing and distance between these corners as shown on map. I set a 1 1/2 inch pipe on true line and midway between these corners for the 1/16 th corner on which the descriptions base the point of beginning. From this 1/16th corner I surveyed the boundraies of the tracts, substituting the true bearings and distances where the original descriptions were in error. Record bearings and distances shown on map with true bearings and distances.

Note: The quarter corner should be perpetuated with a better pipe and witnwssed.
