PURPOSE OF SURVEY: Pursuant to Client's request and direction, perform a boundary survey, recover existing monuments, establish monuments at boundary corners as needed and file a Map of Survey in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.


SURVEY PROCEDURE: Utilizing Trimble 5700 GPS equipment and Real-time Kinematic methods utilizing the Oregon Real-time GPS Network (ORGN), a Trimble S6 Robotic Total Station and Trimble TSC2 Data Collectors with Trimble Survey Controller software all found monuments were tied within closed loop traverses or via redundant ties. Records utilized for this survey: Instrument Number 2011-013672 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon; and DARBY GRIFFIN CREEK SUBDIVISION NO. 1, a plat recorded June 15, 1954, in Volume 7 of Plats at Page 15 of the Records of Jackson County, Oregon (also on file in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.

Subject property is described within Tracts 1 and 2 of said Instrument Number 2011-016372, being portions of Lot 8, Block 1, DARBY GRIFFIN CREEK SUBDIVISION, NO. 1 (referred to hereafter as "DGCS"). Utilizing said RTK and ORGN, located and tied the Northeast corner of Donation Land Claim (DLC), No. 40, the West-Southwest corner DLC 40, the Southeast corner of DLC 41, the Northeast corner DLC 46 and the North-Northwest corner DLC 47, and a 1-inch diameter iron pin (held for the Northeast corner of DGCS). Searched for all exterior boundary and interior lot corners of DGCS.

Held the bearing between the Southeast corner of DLC 41 and the West-Southwest of DLC 40 for the Basis of Bearings for this survey and the centerline of a portion of Griffin Creek Road per said DGCS (said bearing differs to DGCS bearing counterclockwise at 00°01'13"). Utilizing said monuments and bearing basis, computed the exterior boundaries of DGCS as follows: from the Northeast corner, held rotated bearing at intersection with said West line DLC 40 to establish the Northwest corner; held the distance of 236.1 feet from the Northeast corner DLC 46 along the east line thereof, to compute an angle point on the exterior boundary (from which held rotated bearing northeasterly to establish an angle point on the exterior boundary); from which, held the distance of 1.24 feet along said east line DLC 46 to establish the Southwest corner of said subdivision; from said Southwest corner held the distance of 518.76 feet on the rotated bearing (which returned a bearing of South, matching plat bearing) from the Northeast corner, to establish the Southeast corner (Initial Point). An additional search of all subdivision corners was made, but no additional corners were found.
