

LOCATION:

Located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, and the Southwest Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 32 South, Range 3 East, Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument two tracts owned by PacifiCorps Energy. The tracts are described in Volume 187, Page 612 and Volume 192, Page 382, Deed Records, Jackson County, Oregon.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

Bearings are based on monuments found from Survey No. 12624.

PROCEDURE:

The Northwest Quarter of Section 34 and the Southeast Quarter of Section 27 were surveyed by Edwards Surveying and Land Planning, Inc. in 1991 and 1996 and filed as Surveys No. 12624 and 14817. Several Government corners and set monuments shown on those two surveys were located and tied by traverse. In his narrative for Survey No. 12624 (also surveying PacifiCorps property), David Edwards states that he held record deed description bearings to achieve the best fit when compared to existing canal locations. I also found this to be the case for these two tracts. Volume 187, Page 612 describes the centerline of an 80 foot wide strip of land which commences at the southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34. I was unable to recover the monument set by Mr. Edwards at this location but found an iron pin from the same survey further north on the line. The tract description terminates on the northsouth centerline of Section 27, and gives a call to the south quarter corner of said Section 27. Volume 192, Page 382 is a metes and bounds description which commences at a 1" iron pipe located at the southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 27. Mr. Edwards found this pipe during Survey No. 14817 but set a pin a little more than a foot away from it. I did not use his pin but held the called-for pipe. The metes and bounds description comes back to the north-south centerline of Section 27 and makes a call to the south quarter corner that allows the north lines of the two descriptions to end at the same point. These two deeds were recorded in 1931 and 1932 respectively. The metes and bounds description does not close by almost eight feet and, between the two deeds, only one monument is called for and described. Arguments could be made for several alternate locations for these tracts. I chose to match the (PacifiCorps) work done by Mr. Edwards on the westerly end of the tracts and I held the record distance from the called- for pipe on the east end of the tracts. This solution fit reasonably well with the existing canal location.

A Topcon 3002 total station and Ashtech GPS units were used for this survey.
