PURPOSE:

To survey and monument two parcels created through a Land Partition. See JCDS File No. SUB2011-00062. The parent tract being Parcel 1 set forth in

Doc. 2008-021811, ORJCO.

Made ties to existing monuments as shown on Sheet 2 to control this Survey. Computed the centerline and right of way of Highway 99 per State Highway Maps filed in the Jackson County Surveyor's Office. The right of way of Savage Creek Road was determined by holding 30 feet from the existing painted centerline. Research at the Jackson County Road Department revealed no hard evidence of a surveyed location or width from the original petition set forth in Volume 3, Page 211 of County Road Records dated June 1900. Per Statute the right of way width for this time period is 60 feet. The occupation along this portion of Savage Creek Road reveals this portion of the road has not moved in decades. Based on the lack of hard evidence to the contrary, I hold the centerline stripe as the center of the 60 foot right of way. The South line of the subject tract were held as monumented by FS8078. The East line was held as set forth in Doc. 2004-048050, ORJCO being the existing fence line which fit the monuments per FS8078 and a 1 inch iron pipe near the N.E. corner. Set monuments at the locations shown on Sheet 2 based on the approved Tentative Plat. Equipment used in this survey were utilizing Trimble R6 GPS receivers and Topcon GTS6000 total station.
