

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing a Topcon total station and reflecting prisms I tie the monuments as shown. The center line intersection at Fern and Roca was perpetuated by intersection between found monuments per survey numbers 5655 and 13241. At the intersection of Fern and Elkader the center line of Fern Street was projected from the intersection of Roca and Fern to intersect to the midpoint between the found monument at the southwest corner of the Elkader and Fern street intersection per survey number 10124 and the found 3/4 inch iron pipe at the north west corner of said street intersection. The line of found monuments per filed survey numbers 7458 and 10124, along the west side of Elkader was held and offset 30 feet East and projected to intersect the center line of Fern Street. The 3/4 inch iron pipe accepted as the southwest corner of the Galey Addition was tied and a line parallel with Fern Street was projected to intersect the southerly projection of the above mentioned west line of Elkader Street. I then calculate the block and proportion the Lots as shown on the accompanying plat. The parent tract, as described in Volume 382 at Page 271 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, of the affected Lot is described as all of Lot 32 and the northerly 5 feet of Lot 35 of the Galey Addition, excepting a 120 foot east-west and 10 foot north-south portion of the northwest corner of Lot 32 as shown on the accompanying plat. The subsequent deed as described in Volume 385 at Page 162 of said records is described with record bearings and distances per the plat for the western 120 feet of the parent tract. As said deed is senior, I hold the full 120 feet as called from the East line of Elkader Street as shown. The proportioning results in a shorter distance from the point of commencement to the point of beginning as called for in said volume and page. Also the remainder results in shortened dimensions that described in Instrument Number 95-01064 as it is constrained as the junior deed.



LOCATION:

A portion of Lots 32 and 35 of the Galey Addition to the City of Medford in the Northwest Quarter of Section 15, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument that tract described in Instrument Number 95-01064 of the Official Record of Jackson County, Oregon.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

Basis of Bearing is the center line of Roca Street between the found brass cap monument at Roca and Prospect Streets and the intersection of Roca and Fern Streets as derived from found monuments at as shown on the accompanying plat per filed survey number 13241 at the Jackson County Surveyor's Office, Oregon - said bearing being North 0°15'38" East.
