Butler Lane controls the south line of Lot 25 and I recovered nine survey monuments intended to be on the right of way along the mile long portion dividing said Block "I". Charles R. Smith established right of way pins along Butler Lane in 2007 & 2008 in Survey No.'s 19670 and 20124, but I do not agree with the rationale as explained in the Survey Narrative to determine the right of way on the west end of Butler where he holds a monument set by Survey No. 15063 that was described by that survey as being "plus or minus" from the south right-of-way of Butler Lane and partially based on another "unrecorded" pipe. That right-ofway resolution did not very closely fit the deed or plat records for I found that by the south line of Lot 25 being 409 feet deep. holding four monuments along the south line of Butler Lane denoted on Survey No.'s 2641, 4187, 9883 & 17983, surveyed between 1964 and 1984 and projecting the line between those monuments westerly to Valley View Road, fit very well with the 409 foot record depth of Lot 25, as well as the overall record width of said Block "I". Valley View Road was determined by holding the centerline monument re-established by the Jackson County Surveyor by Survey No. 11446 in 1988 which was tied to the southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 45 that matched exactly with this survey.

BASIS OF BEARING: The Basis of Bearing for this survey is the south line of Butler Lane, having a record plat bearing of North 89°39'55" West, as referenced on Survey No. 4187 on file in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.

LOCATION: The Southeast Quarter of Section 30 in Township 38 South, Range

1 East of the Willamette Meridian in Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To survey and monument a property line adjustment between those

tracts of land described within Instrument No. 94-37827 of the

Official Records in Jackson County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing an electronic Leica TCRP 1203 robotic total station with

ranging prisms in conjunction with a Leica 1200 GNSS Smart Rover operating on the Oregon Department of Transportation

ORGN Network, I survey the lands as shown.

The parent tract of the subject parcels is Lot 25, Block "I", Rogue River Valley Orchard Co.'s Orchard 10 Acre Tracts, recorded on October 3, 1908 in Volume 139, Page 140 of the Plat Records in Jackson County, Oregon. As numerous other surveyors have noted previously in public survey records within the above referenced orchard tracts, including our office in the performance of Survey No. 20891, little to no evidence of original monumentation within these tracts remain today. The best available information that I could find to locate Lot 25 within all of Block "I", were monuments found and set by George Burrell in 1968 from Survey No. 3785 and Verlyn Thomas from Survey No. 3082 in 1966, of which five monuments were recovered by this survey to determine the northwest and northeast corners of said Lot 25.
