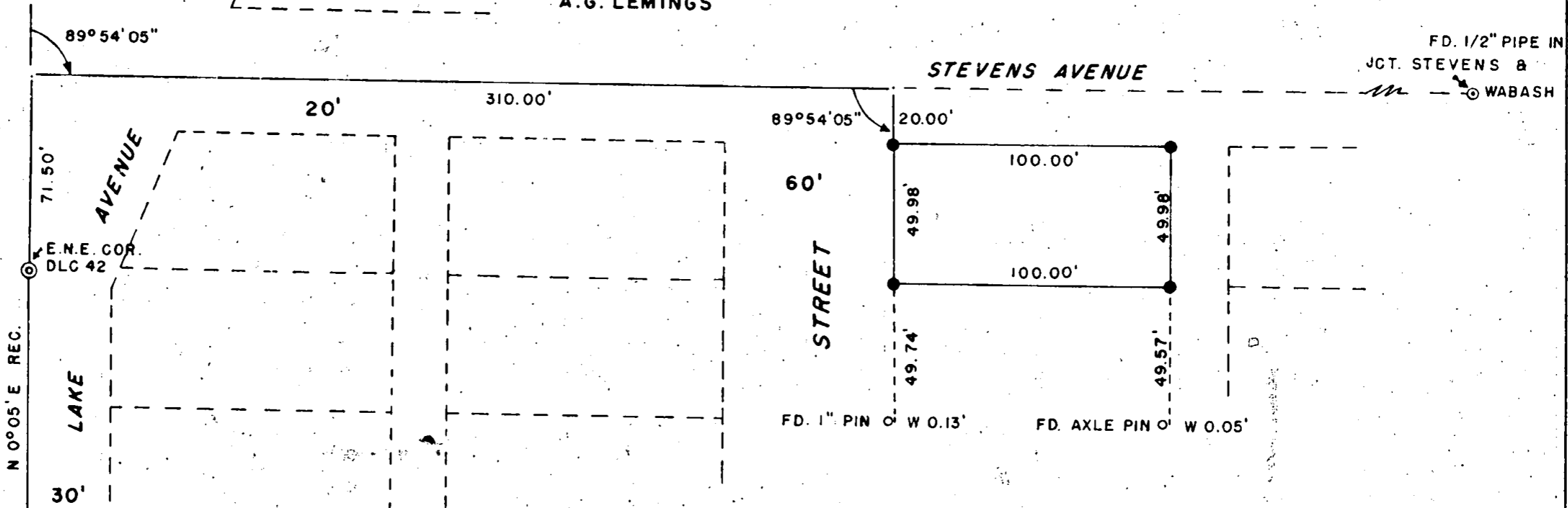

Basis of bearing: Plat record.

Purpose of survey: To locate the corners of Lot 1, Block 2 of  
Laurelhurst Addition to the city of Medford.

Equipment of survey: 100' steel tape and optical transit.

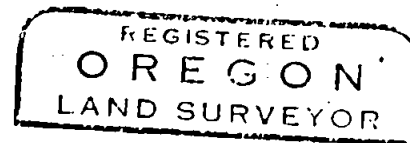
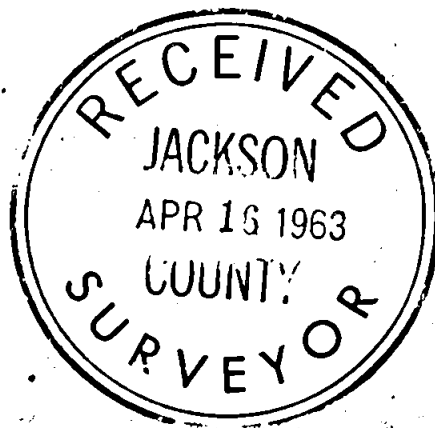
Procedure of survey: Held control previously established per  
recorded surveys 925 and 1433.

Commenced at the ENE corner of DLC 42, said corner being a  
brass cap in case, and proceeded as shown on the attached plat.

Axle pin monuments found south of the surveyed parcel were  
set by Registered Engineer Hugh Ingle in 1947 according to  
resident Clyde Hillyer.

The spike found at the junction of Saling and Crater Lake  
Avenue was found to be 0.02' West of the line of sight through  
to the cased monument at Jackson Street.
