

PURPOSE: To replace and reference an existing 2" brass cap monument in a monument well prior to it's destruction by a newly placed sewer line, per 0.R.S 209.150. This monument is located at the centerline intersection of Laurel Street and 5th Street in Central Point, Oregon.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a Trimble R-8 GPS receiver I tied the existing monument as referred in filed survey number 3547. I then set references as noted on the map to perpetuate the centerline monument. After the sewer project was completed and the final pavement laid, I set a 5/8"x 24" iron rod with an aluminum cap marked "LS 2359" at the centerline intersection point.
