

#### PROCEDURE:

The subject property is the product of a property line adjustment between Lot 13 and Lot 14 of the Thunderbird Heights Subdivision. The results of the property line adjustment was filed as Survey No. 8086. This survey proceeded by searching for monuments shown on Filed Survey No 8086. Monuments from this survey were found in good condition at the north, south, and east corners of the subject property. The calculated position of the monument at the northwesterly corner of the subject property, being the corner common to Lot 12 and Lot 13 of the subdivision is occupied by a 4"x4"wooden fence post in concrete. No evidence of the monument was found.

In order to replace that monument the survey was extended to search for original monuments along the cul-de-sac from the Thunderbird Heights Subdivision for use in proportioning a position for the corner. The only original monument found along the cul-de-sac was the monument at the southwest corner of Lot 12. The other monument found on the cul-de-sac was the monument set on Filed Survey No. 8086 for the adjusted line. This monument is not an original subdivision monument however it was set from original monuments that existed at the time of the survey. Proportionate measure from these two monuments yields a position for the northwesterly corner of Lot 13 that conforms with the record bearing and distance from the found original monument at the northeast corner of Lot 13. Though holding record distance from the found original corner was considered, the former procedure was used for establishing the corner.

A witness monument was set at this location since, as stated, the actual corner is occupied by the fence post.

This survey was accomplished using a Topcon GPT 3002W total station and conventional surveying techniques.




