### SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

Purpose: This survey is a retracement of S/N 4209 and the deed recorded as Instrument No 2002-36184 in the Official Records of Jackson County to re-establish missing monuments at the request of our client.

Procedure: Our work on this property started in 2002 and consisted of water rights application. In the course of conducting the water rights work we tied the found corners shown as found hereon, including the monument that was reset at the location it was found. Over the years the following equipment was used to conduct the survey work; Trimble 4000SI, 5700, 5800 and R-8 GPS receivers and a Trimble 5600 Robotic Total Station. S/N 4209 performed by Claude Masters reports that 1/2 inch iron pins were set while the deed of record calls for an iron rod with no dimensions. We found 5/8 iron pins. The survey and deed document descriptions are consistent with each other. The found monuments are considered deed corners. While there is a dimension difference of the found monuments and set monuments they fit the survey reasonably well and have been relied on as demonstrated by the existing lines of occupation for the last 45 years. Based on all of this evidence the found monumentation was held and replaced as noted. Our client was not interested in the monuments along the river so the southwest corner was re established between the found monuments of the original survey/deed data adjusted by a compass adjustment with both ends fixed to the existing monuments. The tie to the Northeast corner of Government Lot 4 is reported per the original survey.
