SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

FOR: ELK LUMBER COMPANY

PURPOSE: To rehabilitate and perpetuate the section corner common to Sections

1 and 12, Township 33 South, Range 3 East and Sections 6 and 7,

Township 33 South, Range 4 East, W.M.

## PROCEDURE:

Found the original Southeast BT which is now an II inch White Fir snag, badly decayed but with scribe marks in upper face exposed and plainly legible. Found Chinquapin sprout growth at record position of Northeast BT. Found no trace of the other BT's as this area was burned over in 1910 and has since been heavily logged. Found the original corner monument which is properly oriented and set firmly in the ground. However, this monument falls 1.2 feet North of the corner position as determined by the record bearing and distance from the original Southeast BT. Since the stone is in the edge of a skidroad and there is a definite possibility that it may have been disturbed in logging and replaced in a position other than its original. I set the corner point at the record bearing and distance from the original Southeast BT and monumented with a linch by 36 inch galvanized steel pipe & driven 30 inches in the ground and capped with a 1-1/2 inch to 1 inch galvanized bell reducer filled with pot metal and stamped as shown below in 1/8 inch letters and numerals:

I did not disturb the original stone monument and it lies 1.2 feet North of the above-described pipe monument.
