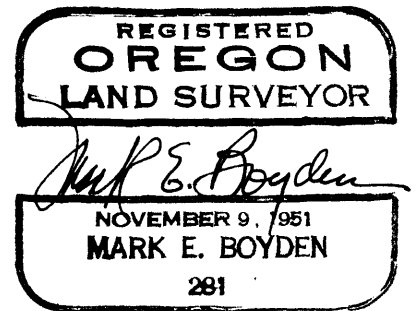

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: Robert Watson
Rt. 1, Box 22
Central Point, Oregon

LOCATION: Easterly portion of CRATER PARK SUBDIVISION,
now vacated, in Section 33, Township 36 South,
Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian.

PURPOSE: To monument and describe three parcels within
the Watson contract ownership proposed to be sold.

PROCEDURE:

Found iron bolt lot corners as set on CRATER PARK
SUBDIVISION for control of Eric Avenue, the Southwesterly
boundary of Interstate Highway No. 5, and the Jackson
Creek boundaries. A tie to a right-of-way pin on the
Southwesterly boundary of Interstate Highway No. 5 near
the Southeast corner of CRATER PARK SUBDIVISION, indicated
differences between the highway boundary on CRATER PARK
SUBDIVISION, and the final monumented highway boundary.
These differences were so minor, that a retracement of the
highway boundary was not considered to be warranted at this
time. However, the legal description was so prepared
to run to the true highway boundary to include any minor
location differences that exist.

Monumented the parcels as shown, using for
meridian control, the solar bearings established on
CRATER PARK SUBDIVISION.
