SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR: Ron DeLuca

LOCATION: The Northwest & Northeast Quarters of Section 9 in Township 39 South,

Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, City of Ashland, Jackson

County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To survey and monument Tract A and Tract B of the lands described

within Instrument No. 2014-016430 of the Official Records in Jackson

County, Oregon.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing an electronic Leica TCRP 1203 robotic total station with

ranging prisms, in conjunction with survey control previously established by this office during the performance of Survey No. 20610, on file in the

office of the Jackson County Surveyor, I survey the land as shown.

The subject tract lies within portions of Lots 3, 4 & 5 of McCall's Addition to the City of Ashland, Recorded on June 16, 1888 in Volume 16, Pages 71 & 72 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon. No original monuments have been found or documented within McCall's Addition, but it is bounded on all three sides by street right-of-ways with sufficient centerline monuments to determine the subject boundaries.

Siskiyou Boulevard and East Main Street centerlines were surveyed and re-established by Mark Boyden by Survey No. 4267 and the 1960 relocated Sherman Street was surveyed by George Burrell in Survey No.

7850 and held for position.

There have been numerous Boundary Line Agreements made for most of the subject property lines in the late 1970's and early 1980's which are depicted hereon, as well as on Survey No.'s 7788 and 7850. The legal description for Tract A matches the survey record from Boyden's Survey No. 7788 which fit very well with the three recovered pins from that survey and Burrell's Survey No. 7850 which were held for position. A 4.00 witness corner was established because the northeast corner of the adjacent tract described within Instrument No. 2006-010078 fell right at the northeast building corner and a monument could not be placed any closer to the corner because of the building wall was right on the property line.

BASIS OF BEARING: The Basis of Bearing for this survey is the centerline of Siskiyou

Boulevard, having a record plat bearing of North 56°07'40" West, as referenced on Survey No. 20610, on file in the office of the Jackson

County Surveyor.
