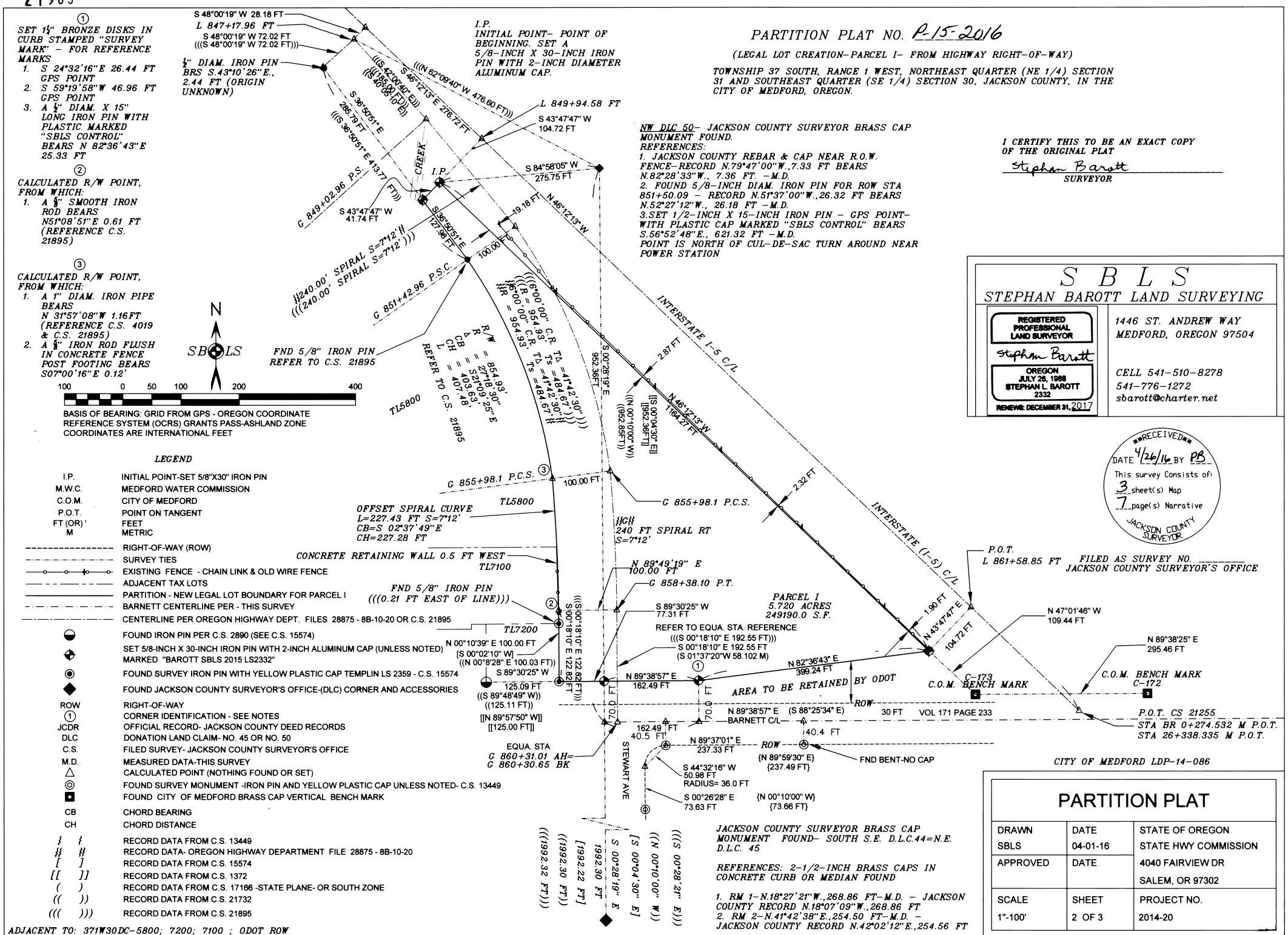

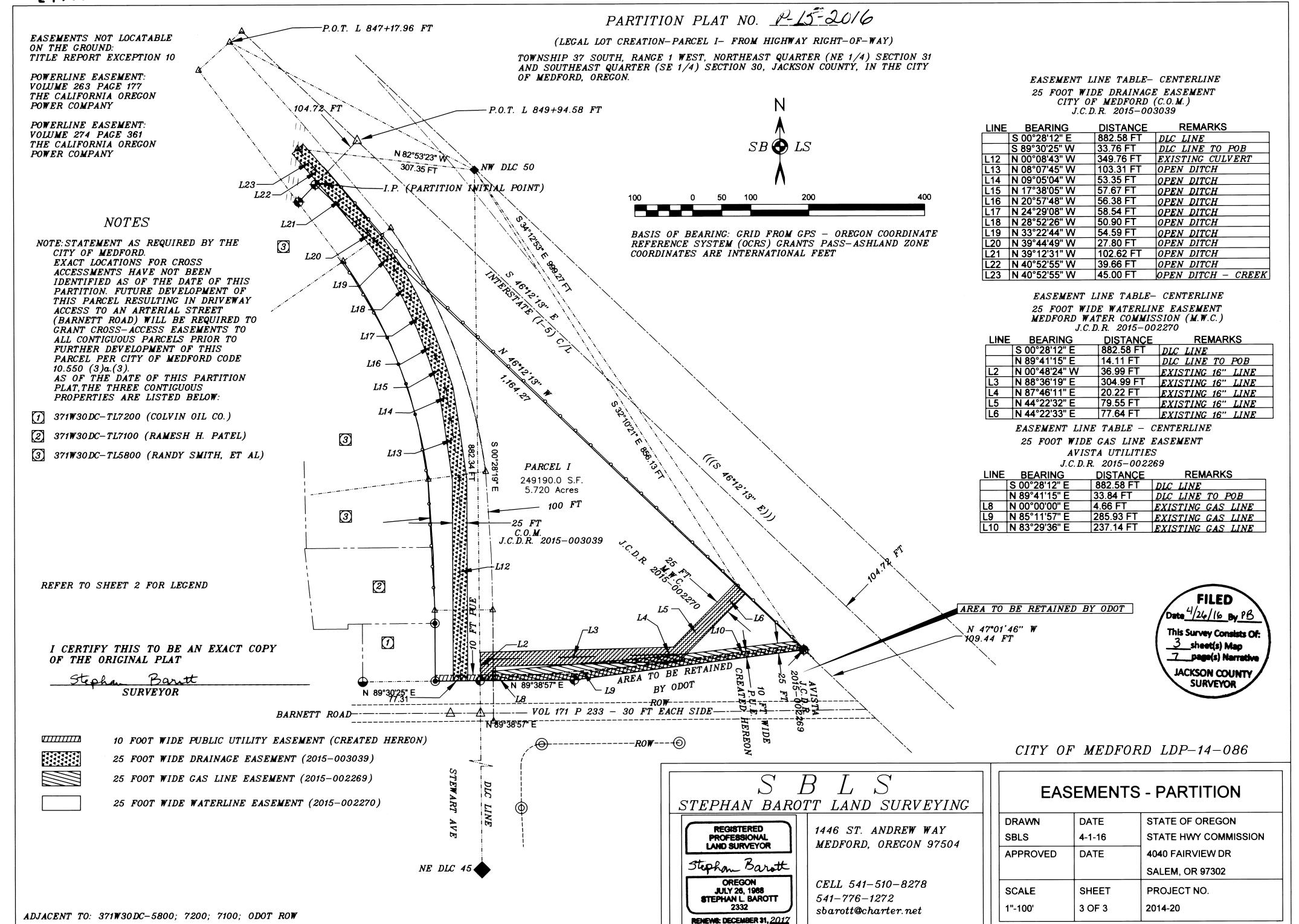

LOCATION: A parcel of land lying in the Napoleon B. Evans Donation Land Claim (DLC) No. 44 and the Francis Ball DLC No. 50, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Northeast quarter (NE ½) of Section 31 and the Southeast Quarter (SE ½) of Section 30, Willamette Meridian, City of Medford, Jackson County, Oregon.

BASIS OF BEARING: Grid Bearing from GPS, Oregon Coordinate Reference System (OCRS) Grants Pass-Ashland Zone. Average mapping angle 0°19′10″.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this survey is to create a legal lot from a portion of State Highway Right-of-Way now classified by the State of Oregon as surplus property. This one lot partition will remove, or segregate 5.720 acres of now unused Highway Right-of-Way property once utilized as the South Medford Interchange, south-bound on-off ramp for Pacific Highway No. 1, Interstate Five (I-5). The final parcel will result in the following:

- The Westerly boundary will be adjacent to and share a common boundary with three private parcels.
- The Northeasterly boundary will adjacent to and parallel with the centerline of Pacific Highway No. 1, Interstate 5.
- The Southerly boundary will be a line seventy (70) feet Northerly from the centerline of Barnett Road for the Westerly 240 feet, more or less, of the parcel. The line will then follow a line to the Northeast at variable distances from the centerline of Barnett Road for approximately 400 feet to the intersection of the Northeast boundary of said parcel. ODOT will retain ownership of the area outside of the existing sixty (60) foot City of Medford Right-of-Way for Barnett Road.

HISTORY OF SURVEYS: The history of surveys of T.37 S., R. 1 W. pertaining to this survey is as follows:

The original subdivision of Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian was surveyed by Ives and Hyde under contract No. 39 dated January 4, 1854.

Donation Land Claim No. 44 (Napoleon B. Evans DC patent No. 27 dated 8-19-1865) was surveyed by Sewell Truax on or about October 16, 1855.

Donation Land Claim No. 50 (Francis Ball DC patent No. 1089 dated 7-19-1876) was surveyed by Sewell Truax on or about October 16, 1855.

- C.S. 1372- Leland P. Lovejoy, LS 262, dated February 10, 1960. During this survey, Lovejoy retraced the DLC line between DLC 44 and 50, and tied to the centerline of a portion of Barnett Road. I used this survey to establish a point on the calculated centerline of Barnett Road, and offset from said point, 70 feet Northerly for the Southerly line of this partition plat.
- C.S. 2890-Jack Hoffbuhr, LS 222, dated September 4, 1965. Retraced a portion of the West line of this current partition. Hoffbuhr noted finding a "boat spike" in the center of Barnett Road on the DLC line, but did not report a location of it by bearing or distance.
- C.S. 4019- Mark E. Boyden, LS 281, dated May 20, 1969. Retraced a portion of the West line of this current partition. Boyden noted as finding 5/8-inch diameter iron pins at or near the curved Highway Right-of-Way for the West line of this current partition. Boyden stated these found 5/8-inch diameter iron pins were out of position, but did not document their actual location. Boyden set 1-inch diameter galvanized iron pipes "at the true corner locations." A search for these Boyden monuments was unsuccessful. However, several of the 5/8-inch iron pins were recovered.
- C.S. 12671-Hardy Engineering, John Hardey LS 1990, dated August 1991. Documented a portion of the South Right-of-Way line for Barnett Road. Hardy did show ties to found "apparent ROW pins" for I5 during this survey.
- C.S. 13449-South Gateway Center Subdivision- Hardy Engineering, John Hardey, LS 1990, dated November 9, 1992. Hardy documented a portion of the South Right-of-Way line for Barnett Road. During this subdivision, an additional 10 feet to the South half of Barnett Road was dedicated for public street right of way.
- C.S. 15574-Richard G. Templin, LS 2359, dated September 1, 1997. Documented a portion of the West line of this partition plat and identified the Colvin Oil Chevron property (current Tax Lot 371W30DC-7200). In general, the Templin survey was a retracement of the Lovejoy survey CS 1372.
- C.S. 16301- Oregon Department of Transportation, John Pariani, LS 51382, dated October 19, 1999. Horizontal Control and Monument Recovery Survey. Documented a portion of the South Right-of-Way for Barnett Road (survey C.S. 13449) and tied to the Donation Land Claim line for DLC 44 and DLC 50.
- C.S. 17166-Oregon Department of Transportation, John Pariani, LS 51382, dated January 9, 2002. Horizontal Control and Monument Recovery Survey. Documented a portion of the South Right-of-Way for Barnett Road and tied to the Donation Land Claim line for DLC 44 and DLC 50.The

horizontal datum used was NAD 83(1991) with basis of bearing was Grid, Oregon South Zone. Coordinates were converted to a Local datum Plane (LDP) in meters.

C.S. 18071-Oregon Department of Transportation, through a contract with OTAK's surveyor John Carlson, LS 2044, dated December 4, 2003. Horizontal Control and Monument Recovery Survey. Documented a portion of the South Right-of-Way for Barnett Road and tied to the Donation Land Claim line for DLC 44 and DLC 50.

The horizontal datum used was NAD 83(1991) with basis of bearing was Grid, Oregon South Zone. Coordinates were converted to a Local datum Plane (LDP) in International Feet.

C.S. 19357-Oregon Department of Transportation, Stuart Cappello, LS 52908, dated September 29, 2006. Horizontal Control and Monument Recovery Survey. This survey established the GPS Control Stations 1096401-1096404 referred to later in this narrative. The horizontal datum used was NAD 83(1998) with basis of bearing was Grid, Oregon South Zone. Coordinates were converted to a Local datum Plane (LDP) in meters.

C.S. 21255-Oregon Department of Transportation, Stuart Cappello, LS 52908, dated April, 2013. Horizontal Control and Monument Recovery Survey. Documented a portion of the South Right-of-Way for Barnett Road and tied to the Donation Land Claim line for DLC 44 and DLC 50. The horizontal datum used was NAD 83(2011) epoch 2010.0 utilizing the Oregon Real Time GPS Network (ORGN) with basis of bearing converted to Grid, Oregon South Zone from survey C.S. 17166. Coordinates were converted to a Local datum Plane (LDP) in meters. This survey was part of an ODOT Control Net Survey.

C.S. 21732--Polaris Land Surveying, Shawn Kampmann, LS 2883, dated May 6, 2015. Documented a portion of the south Right-of-Way line for Barnett Road and tied to the Donation Land Claim line for DLC 44 and DLC 50. It must be noted, Surveyor Kampmann started at the SE DLC 44 Corner and surveyed North along the DLC line per the record distance in Volume 171 Page 223 to the centerline of Barnett Road. This current survey utilized the distance as shown Survey No. 1372, starting at the NW DLC 50 Corner and surveying South along the common DLC to the center of Barnett Road. The two surveys do not come to a common point for the center of Barnett Road, and differ by about 0.5 feet.

C.S. 21895- Oregon Department of Transportation, Scott R. Morrison, LS 2674, dated January 8, 2016. Horizontal Recovery and Retracement Map. This survey documented the Old Barnett Road Interchange for Pacific Highway No. 1 (I5) M.P. 27.58 to M.P. 27.90. This survey documented the Westerly boundary and the centerline of Pacific Highway No. (I5) in the immediate area of this partition plat. This survey resolved several issues discovered during my initial investigation recovery of monuments and preliminary survey of the partition area. The horizontal datum used was NAD83 (2011) epoch 2010.00, and vertical is NAVD88 using Geoid 12A. The control established by Scott Morrison was accepted and held as marking the true boundaries of the Old Barnett Road Interchange and the centerline of Pacific Highway No. 1 (I5) as they relate to the boundaries of this partition plat.

Highway Right-of-Way files 8B-10-20 dated August 1958, 9B-22-16 dated March 1985, 1A-23-16 dated May 2004, with more recent updates.

No other private surveys of record that are directly connected to this Property are noted. More information can be found in the ODOT project folders for this area. That data can be accessed with a request for information from the State of Oregon.

PROCEDURE:

Prior to commencement of this survey, deed records of the ODOT property as well as the adjacent deeds were evaluated. A review of surveys of record recorded in the Office of the Jackson Surveyor outlined in the history of surveys were also evaluated.

Extensive field investigations and monument recovery were previously recorded by the Oregon Department of Transportation's Geometronics Unit, Right-of-Way Section, as filed surveys CS 16301, CS 17166, CS 18071, CS 19357, CS 21255, and CS 21895, as well as drawing 1A-23-16 were utilized for control where needed. These surveys document the ODOT ownership and centerline data for Interstate 5 and Barnett Road. Utilizing the Oregon Department of Transportation's Real Time GPS Network (ORGN). The most recent survey, CS 21895 documents the centerline Pacific Highway No.1 (I5) as well as the Westerly boundary of this partition plat.

The Highway right-of –way acquisition Deeds referred to in the Legal Description on page 1 of this partition plat were based on the Oregon Coordinate System, South Zone, and were noted in feet. Many different "adjustments" to the Oregon Coordinate System have occurred over the years, causing differences to the bearings and coordinates.

The adjacent private deeds were for the most part based on Geodetic (solar) bearings, and did not utilize the Oregon State Plane Coordinate System.

West Boundary

The Westerly boundary of this partition plat is generally described as being one-hundred (100) feet westerly from the centerline of the "old off ramp centerline, or "G" line" as described in Highway Project Files 28875, 23066, Circuit Court Case No. 61-279-L and 8B-10-20. Several local surveys of record have attempted to locate this Westerly "offset line" over the years. The most recent survey by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) documents this boundary well. Refer to filed survey CS 21895 dated January 8, 2016. This survey was accepted and held as marking the true boundary of the old off ramp centerline.

Leland P. Lovejoy, LS 262 surveyed the parcel known today as the Colvin Oil Chevron Property (371W30DC-7200). During this survey, Lovejoy tied to the Donation Land Claim line for DLC 44 and 50, and documented the centerline of Barnett Road. Lovejoy then established monuments 70 feet Northerly of said centerline. Lovejoy started on the North (NW Corner of DLC 50) and surveyed South along the DLC line to the center of Barnett Road. It must be noted that other deeds for this area start on the South, and survey North along this same DLC line and measure a different position for the

center of Barnett Road, by 0.4-0.5 feet. For this partition plat, I determined the best fit would be to hold the Lovejoy measurement along the DLC line of 952.36 feet to establish the centerline of Barnett Road. My client's intent is to then offset 70 feet Northerly to establish the Southerly boundary of this Partition. Richard G. Templin, LS 2359, surveyed this same Colvin Oil parcel as documented in filed survey CS 15574. Monuments set by Templin were recovered and held as marking a portion of the westerly boundary of this partition plat.

Mark E. Boyden, LS 281 documented a portion of the Westerly boundary of this partition plat with filed survey CS 4019. Boyden noted finding several unrecorded 5/8-inch diameter iron pins apparently marking the State Right-of-Way, which he stated "were inconsistent within themselves. One-inch galvanized iron pipes were set for the true Right-of-Way corners to eliminate confusion with the 5/8-inch iron pins found." Boyden did not document the actual location of said found iron pins. I did find one of the Boyden 1-inch diameter iron pipes out of position. I also found several of the 5/8-inch diameter iron highway Right-of-Way pins.

Scott Morrison from ODOT also found the several iron pins or pipes, some of which were described by Boyden. Refer to CS 21895.

Circuit Court Case No. 61-279-L (Final Judgement)- Plaintiff-The STATE OF OREGON, by and through its State Highway Commission. This judgement dated November 10, 1961 allowed the State of Oregon to purchase real property partially described as follows:

A portion of the description of the judgement is as follows:

Parcel No. 2:

A strip of land lying in the Southeast quarter (SE1/4) of Section 30, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; the said parcel being bounded on the Southeasterly side by that property described in that deed to William C. Earhart, recorded in Book 163, page 46 of Jackson County Deed Records; bounded on the Northeasterly side by parcel No. 1; bounded on the Southwesterly side by the following described line:

Beginning on the Southwesterly line of Parcel No. 1, at a point which is opposite and 71.99 feet Southwesterly of Station "G" 847+17.96 Feet on the connection road between the relocated Pacific Highway No. 1 (I5) and a County road known as Barnett Road; thence Southeasterly in a straight line to a point which is opposite and 100 feet Southwesterly of Station 851+42.96 Feet on said center line which is described as follows:

Beginning at Engineer's centerline Station "G" 847+17.96 Feet, said station being 234.11 feet North and 412.90 feet West of the Northwest corner of the Francis Ball Donation Land Claim No. 50 in Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian; thence South 40°05'10" East, 185 feet; thence on a spiral curve right (the long chord of which bears South 37°41'10" East) 240 feet to Station 851+42.96 Feet, said centerline crossing the Northwesterly line of said William C. Earhart property approximately at Station 851+00 Feet.

The most recent survey by Scott Morrison for the Oregon Department of Transportation filed as survey CS 21895 documents the Westerly boundary well and was held for control for this partition plat.

North Boundary

The northerly boundary of this partition plat is described as being approximately 105 feet southwesterly from the existing centerline of Interstate 5.

The centerline of Pacific Highway No. 1 (I5) was determined by survey and documented in Oregon Department of Transportation's most recent survey filed as CS 21895 dated January 8, 2016.

South Boundary

The southerly boundary of this partition plat is adjacent to Barnett Road, for the most part. As previously described, I held the distance along the Donation Land Claim line, from the NW corner for DLC50 as surveyed by Lovejoy in filed survey CS 1372 to establish a point for the centerline of Barnett Road. No physical monuments or reference points could be found for said Barnett Road centerline. I then held the monument marking the southeast corner of the Colvin Oil property (current tax lot 7200) as described by Richard Templin in filed survey CS 15574, said monument now marking the southwest (SW) corner of this partition plat. Said point also being seventy (70) feet northerly of the calculated centerline of Barnett Road. From said SW corner, I calculated a line parallel with the southerly boundary of the Colvin Oil property as surveyed by Templin easterly to the intersection with the DLC line. From said DLC line, I calculated a line parallel with, and 70 feet Northerly, of the centerline of Barnett Road to an angle point as noted on page 2 of the partition plat. From said angle point, I calculated a straight line to the monument set as the southeast (SE) corner of this partition plat, said point being on the Right-of-Way line for Interstate 5.

As previously described, several deeds and surveys for the parcels to the south of Barnett road, utilize the Southeast (SE) corner for DLC 44 for a point of beginning, and go Northerly along the DLC line for DLC 44 and 50 to the intersection of Barnett Road. The issue is, not all deed descriptions meet at the same point. There is a discrepancy of 0.4-0.5 feet between several deeds as to the location of the centerline of Barnett Road. This discrepancy is noted with ties to two monuments established in filed survey CS 13449 shown on page 2 of this partition plat. Shawn Kampmann, LS 2883 also noted this discrepancy during filed survey CS 21732.

The original Right-of-Way deed for Barnett Road in this general area is recorded in Volume 171, page 233. This Right-of-Way deed to Jackson County to be used as a public road, was sixty (60) feet wide, thirty (30) feet either side of the centerline. For the portion of Barnett Road adjacent to this current partition plat, the City of Medford is now utilizing approximately 52.4 feet North of Barnett Road centerline for road and utility purposes. The original Right-of-Way deed only allowed for thirty (30) feet. I cannot find documentation where the City or County officially acquired additional Right-of-Way from the State of Oregon. This current partition plat does not set the northerly Right-of-Way line for Barnett Road at seventy (70) feet from the centerline of Barnett Road, but establishes the Southerly boundary of the Partition only. A portion of this additional forty (40) feet of State of Oregon property is currently being utilized as a public street. This issue is for future discussion and not a part of this partition plat.

GPS control was established utilizing a Leica GS14 GNSS duel frequency Real Time Kinematic (RTK) GPS adjusted utilizing Oregon Department of Transportation's (ODOT) GPS network-

corrected solutions. Coordinates as shown, with additional information on file with this office are Oregon Coordinate Reference System (OCRS), Grants Pass-Ashland Zone, in International Feet. The current adjustment from ODOT is NAD83 (2011) epoch 2010.00, and vertical is NAVD88 using Geoid 12A.

The Basis of Bearing for this survey is Grid from GPS using the OCRS Coordinate system, Grants pass-Ashland Zone. The average mapping angle at the center of the project area is 0°19'10".

EQUIPMENT:

Equipment utilized throughout this survey includes a Leica TCRP-1203 Robotic Total Station and Leica GS14 GNSS RTK GPS receiver.
