Procedure: Control and boundaries established by S/N 14675, 17024 and 18506 were utilized for this survey. Robert Neathamer surveyed tax lot 800 on August 13, 1995 with filed S/N 14675. We surveyed tax lot 700 on July 24, 2001, S/N 17024 and again on March 31, 2004, S/N 18506 with the focus on these surveys being the north part of tax lot 700. Tax lot 700 was also reconfigured between our two surveys by our office. The two DLC corners controlling the location of Oak Grove Road were tied by GPS observations prior to these surveys. Careful review of the deeds from Volume 245 Page 293 recorded in the Deed Records of Jackson County and the Instrument No.s' 02-21708 and 01-47405 recorded in the Official Records of Jackson County and the surveys resulted in the acceptance of the line surveyed as monumented on the west end and re-monumented on the east end as the fence construction obliterated the original monument at the record angle from the DLC line. As noted hereon the monument on the east end of this survey is set as witness corner 0.75 feet from the corner. This survey also reflects the location of the fence and storage buildings approximately 10 feet north of the surveyed line.
