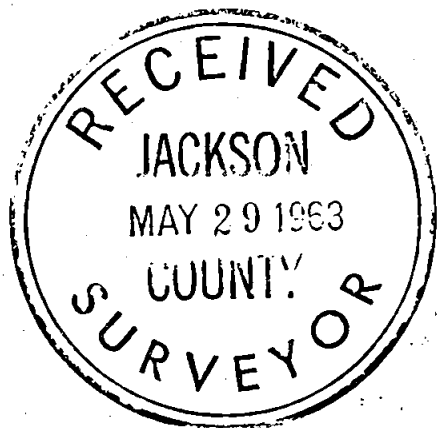
Survey narrative to comply with ORS 209.250

For: Mrs. John E. Patterson, Ashland, Oregon

Purpose: To convey two parcels of land off the original Patterson property.

Procedure: Began survey at the Northeast corner of the Guetzlaff Subdivision, retracing the northeasterly line of the original Bellevue tracts according to the original plat thereof, using the record distances appearing on said plat for resetting the corners of Lot 16 of said tracts. Old iron pipes found for other lot corners along this line. Also retraced the southwesterly line of the Northeasterly tier of lots finding iron pipes for corners along this line.

Found iron pipes as indicated along the west line of Bellevue Avenue for control along the East line of the Patterson tract. The division of this tract as set forth according to the bearings and distances appearing on map.
