

Survey Narrative to comply with Paragraph 209.250, Oregon Revised Statutes.

SURVEY FOR MRS. VOLA TOLMAN, Gold Hill, Oregon.


PURPOSE: To divide the remaining property belonging to Mrs. Tolman, and laying Southeast of Highway 234, into three parcels of more or less equal size.

Property in Sec. 10, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

PROCEEDURY: An inspection of the County deed records disclosed that the Tolman Ownership, remaining Southeast of the Highway #234, extended from a parcel surveyed and described by RE896 and conveyed to Einar Hansen, Deed Records Vol. 527 page 336, on the Southwest to a boundry described as a certain Drain Ditch on the Northeast side the Northeast side. Also Rogue River being the Northwest boundry and Highway #234 as the

Also a check with the Oregon State Road Department disclosed that the altho the present center line of Highway #234 represents a curve, an additional strip has been acquired making the Southeast right-of-way straight. The width of this strip being 68 feet in width at the Northwest corner of the property and the Northeast property line is 70 feet from the centerline as presently marked. No highway monuments are available.

With the monuments, set by RE 896, marking the Northeast boundry of the Hansen property, found-the survey on the balance of the property was completed using the record bearing of this course as a basis, to avoid confusion and disagreement in the Deed Records.
