SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: TO SURVEY AND MONUMENT THE PROPERTY LINE ADJUSTMENT ADDING 45 FEET TO THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF THOSE TRACTS OF LAND DESCRIBED AS LOT 6, LOT 7 AND TRACT A OF PANORAMA HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION, PHASE I, RECORDED IN BOOK 42, PAGE 23 OF THE PLAT RECORDS OF JACKSON COUNTY, OREGON, AND THAT TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED IN INST. NO. 2009—027364, AND 2016—28887 (CADET DRIVE) OF THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF SAID JACKSON COUNTY, PER CITY OF MEDFORD PLANNING DEPARTMENT FILE NO. PLA—16—147.

PROCEDURE: THIS IS A RETRACEMENT OF S/N 20444 WHICH WAS A RETRACEMENT OF THE FOLLOWING S/N 709, 10444, 11723, 19932 AND ALSO 21398 AND 22058 EXCEPT AS AMENDED BY THIS ADJUSTMENT OR AS NOTED. A FIELD SEARCH WAS CONDUCTED AND MONUMENTS OF RECORD WERE TIED A TRIMBLE RTK 5800 AND R8 RECEIVERS AND ROBOTIC 5600 AND S5 TOTAL STATION EQUIPMENT AS SHOWN. THE BOUNDARY OF THE SUBJECT PARCELS WAS HELD TO THESE FOUND MONUMENTS. OUR BEARINGS VARY BY ABOUT 20" ON THE LONG COURSES MEASURED ON THIS SURVEY. AS WE MOVE TO THE MIDDLE AND SOUTHEAST REGION OF THIS SURVEY THE EXISTING MONUMENTS ARE FOUND TO BE OUT OF POSITION BY MUCH MORE THAN THE WEST AND NORTH LINES. DUE TO THE INSTABILITY OF THIS AREA EVIDENCED BY THE RECORD AND MEASURED DIMENSIONS MISSING MONUMENTS WERE SET AT THE DEED RECORD FROM THE NEAREST FOUND MONUMENT PER DEED CALL FOLLOWED BY INVERSE DISTANCES AS NOTED WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE TWO MONUMENTS NOTED AS OUT OF POSITION AS SHOWN HEREON. IT WAS NOTED THAT THE FOUND MONUMENT AT THE EASTERLY END OF THE CURVE DESCRIBED AS "C3" ON THIS SURVEY WAS FOUND TO BE MARKED "HOFFBUHR AND ASSOC., INC.", RECORDS THIS OFFICE WAS UNABLE TO FIND RECORD OF THE FOUND MONUMENT.
