

In 1977, the BLM performed an "Administrative Survey" of Section 13, T38S R2E (see SR-2), at which time the I/I6th corners along the West line of Section 18, T38S R3E were established. Also in 1977, the BLM (1332.0') (S89°49'00"W-2630.0' SR-3) 1331.70 1331.70 S 89°50'37" W - 2630.06' performed "Administrative Surveys" in Sections 18 and 19, T38S S.17 SECTION COR. R3E (see SR-4 & 5), at which time the C.I/4 corner of Section 18 S 89°51'15" W - 2663.40' SECTION COR. S.13 1/4 COR. was set. Then in 1979, the BLM performed an "Administrative $\odot$ BASIS OF BEARING Survey" of the S.1/2 of Section 7, T38S R3E (see SR-3), at which time all the I/16th corners were established. During this survey, all the controlling corners were found and accepted as shown and described hereon. This survey was conducted from April-June of 2017. The control traverses were ran with a "Lecia TSO6+" total station, obtaining a relative accuracy of over 1:20,000. The Weyerhaeuser boundary lines were then marked with 1/2"x6' white fiber glass rods, painted blazes and flagging, as indicated hereon. All corner NE.I/4 NW.1/4 WEY-CO references were measured to the side center of the tree. All new (K)WEY-CO 161.46 AC± 160.43 AC± references added during this survey also have a brass shiner stamped "LS-2069" nailed to the scribed face. No new corners were established during this survey. 
