

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 **OREGON REVISED STATUTES**

SURVEY FOR:

Jonathan Williams 12208 Antioch Road

White City, Oregon 97503

LOCATION:

Southwest quarter of Section 25

Township 35 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian

Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

Property line adjustment survey of the two tax lots owned by the client,

and preparation of map of survey and new lot descriptions.

PROCEDURE:

The properties are described in Doc. No. 1998-46275 and Doc. No. 2003-36843 of the Official Records of Jackson County. The south boundary is controlled by the south boundary of Section 25, as determined from the monuments found at the southwest corner of Section 25, the West 1/16th corner, and at the south quarter corner of Section 25. The north and east boundaries were determined from those monuments shown as found from

CS 20038.

The west boundary, being the easterly right of way boundary of Antioch Road, was located by those three monuments that were set during the course of CS 7926, in July, 1979 and located during the course of this survey. The tangent running southeasterly from the south end of the right of way curve for a distance of 26.18 ft. was held at record bearing from the Jackson County Road Survey, Roll Map 2/3. Note that, from the 5/8 inch diameter pin found at the southerly end of curves B and C, a found 3/4 inch pin, of which the top 3 inches is bent North 79° West 0.2 ft., is in contact with west side of the 5/8 inch pin at the beginning of the bend.

MONUMENTS

The 2½ inch diameter brass cap, set during the course of CS 5442 to mark the corner common to Sections 25, 26, 35 and 36, was found in good condition and marked as described in the notes of said survey. The southwest bearing tree, a 24 inch dia. white oak with healed blazes, bears record South 87°21' West 330.06 ft. The northeast bearing tree, a 20 inch dia. white oak with healed blazes, bears North 89°07' East (record), 284.5 feet to the centerline of the tree at the face of the upper healed blaze.

At the quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 36, found the 2½ dia. brass cap set on Survey No. 3520, and marked "CS 1979" by the County Surveyors Office, exposed 5 inches, 1 ft. north of the 12"x12"x4½ ft. wooden post fence corner, with old wire fences running north, south, east and west. The original northeast bearing tree, 13 inches in diameter with axed-out blazes, dead and soon to fall, was not remeasured.

The southwest bearing tree, marked and described on CS 3520 and now 9 inches in diameter with healed blazes, bears South 34°21" West (record) 8.58 to the face of upper healed blaze.

The northwest bearing tree marked by the County Surveyors Office in 1979, a black oak with healed blazes, is dead and down. I double blazed and measured to a new bearing tree, a 6 inch dia. white oak, which bears North 71°21' West to center of the tree at the lower blaze. I measured 7.90 ft. to a PK nail with washer set horizontal in the southwesterly side of the tree at the lower blaze. The blazes are not scribed.

Basis of bearing:

CS 20038, along the south boundary of Section 25, as shown on the map.
