

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

Located in Block 19, plat of Central Point, being within Donation Land Claim Number 53, in Southwest One-quarter of Northwest One-quarter of Section 11, Township 37 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, in the City of Central Point, Oregon.

PURPOSE OF SURVEY:

Pursuant to Client's request and direction, perform a boundary survey, recover existing monuments, perform a boundary resolution, establish monuments as necessary and file a Map of Survey in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.

SURVEY REFERENCES/PROCEDURES:

Records utilized: Instruments Numbered 2009-023076 and 80-25205 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon; Volume 273 at Page 311, Volume 277 at Page 313, Volume 277 at Page 472, Volume 284 at Page 368, Volume 288 at Page 580 and Volume 385 at Page 400, all of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon; plat of Central Point, recorded June 4, 1887, in Volume 13 at Pages 582 to 585 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon, and noted at the bottom of the plat as checked by C.Z. Boyden on October 27, 1936; and, Surveys Numbered 1375, 3106, 10577, 16677 and 20253, as filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor. Equipment/Software utilized: Trimble S7 Robotic Instrument, Trimble TSC3 data collector with Trimble Access Software; Trimble Business Center and Trimble Terramodel. Linear units: Horizontal is International Foot (ift); Vertical is U.S. Survey Foot (usft). Assumed Cartesian coordinates and a scale factor of 1.0 were utilized for measurements for this survey.

Utilizing said Trimble S7 robotic instrument and TSC3, established primary and secondary control, search and tied monuments and performed topographic measurements.

The subject property is described per said Instrument Number 2009-023076, with references and calls made to volume and pages referenced above, and is located within portions of lots within Block 19, and vacated portions of Cedar Street and alley ways per the plat of Central Point. A search for original monuments per said plat was performed, but nothing was found. After analyzing numerous surveys performed within and near this property, it was decided that the found centerline monuments and Survey Number 1375 were the best available evidence to utilize to solve Block 19 and to define the boundaries of the subject tract of land. The resolution of said boundary was performed as follows:

Centerline of First Street established by holding found monuments at the intersections with Ash and Bush Streets. Centerline of Bush Street, from First Street, easterly, established by holding two found monuments per Surveys Numbered 16677 and 20253 (at the intersections with First and Fourth Streets). Second Street centerline established by holding bearing from the found monument at the intersection with Ash Street, parallel to said established First Street centerline, to its intersection with Bush Street. Cedar Street

centerline established from computed midpoint along Second Street centerline and a bearing per said Survey Number 1375. It should be noted that for Cedar Street, Survey Number 7070 was analyzed, but not utilized due to the fact that the centerline and rights of way therewith, were established by holding midpoint of existing curb lines. Whereas, Survey Number 1375 utilized found monuments to establish Cedar Street. Likewise, Survey Number 12441 was analyzed and not used due to the fact that it utilized monuments per Survey Number 7070.

Utilizing said resolved centerlines, computed the corresponding rights of way therewith, thereby computing the northerly, easterly and the easterly portion of the southerly boundaries of Block 19, plat of Central Point. Utilized Survey Number 1375 to resolve the remainder of the southerly and all of the westerly boundaries of said Block 19, and of said survey. From which, computed the interior lots of said Block 19. Based on the resolved Block 19 and lots therein, utilized said volume and pages to resolve historic boundaries and vacated streets and/or alley ways, and Instrument Number 80-25205 to resolve location of vacated right of way at Cedar Street. From which, utilized said Instrument Number 2009-023076 to resolved the exterior boundaries of the subject tract of land.

Few monuments per Survey Number 1375 were found, and some monuments of unknown origin were also found. It should be noted that per Volume 277 at Page 313, it appears that First Street, from Cedar Street southerly to Bush Street, was vacated. A search was not made to resolve what is depicted on Survey Number 1375 or Jackson County Assessor's map of a 30 feet wide right of way for First Street, as it did not affect the boundaries of this survey.
