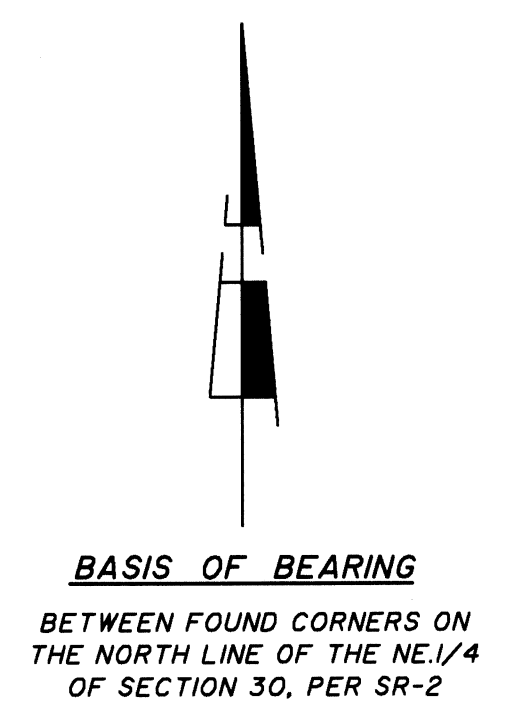
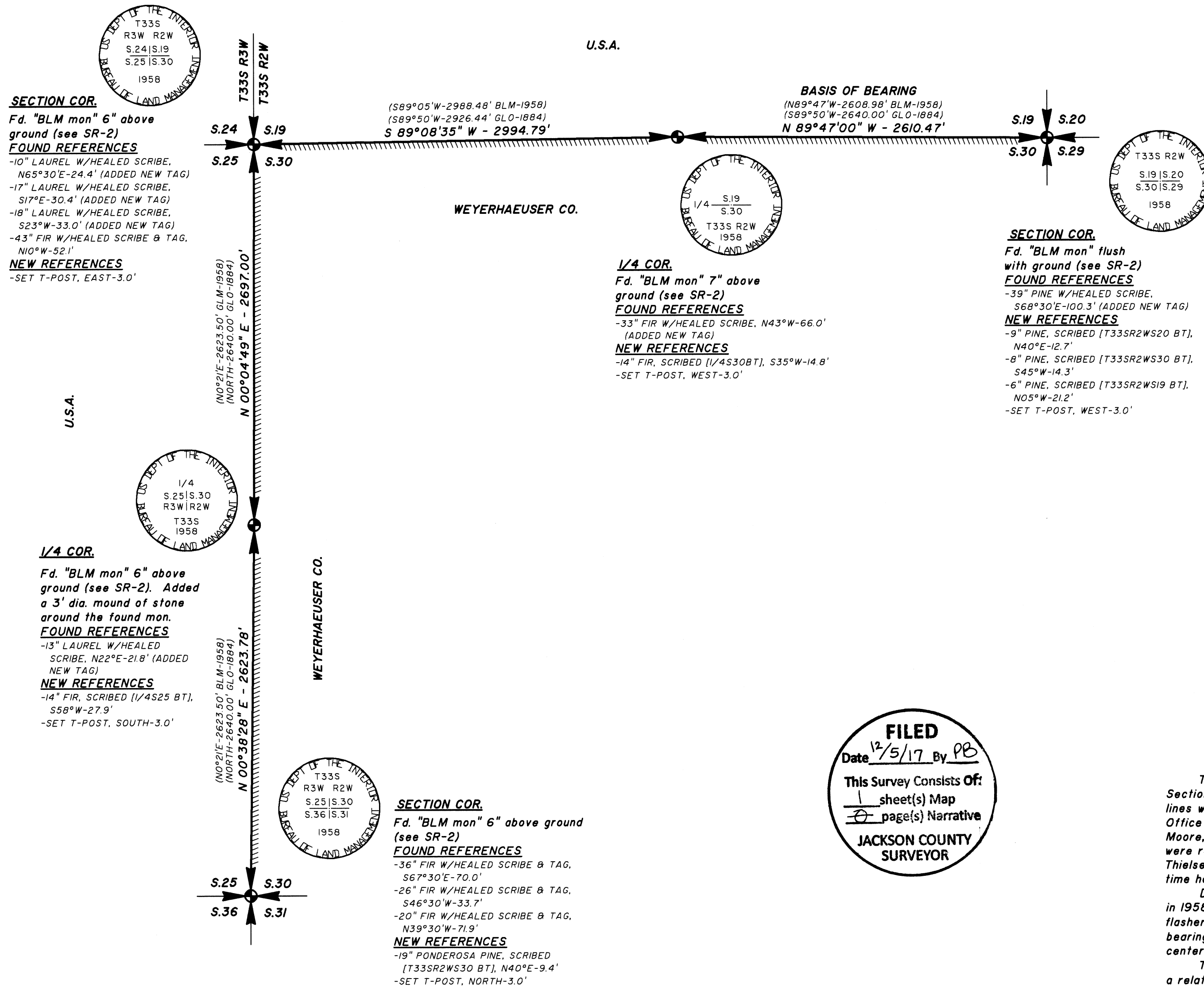


A DEPENDENT RE-SURVEY of the

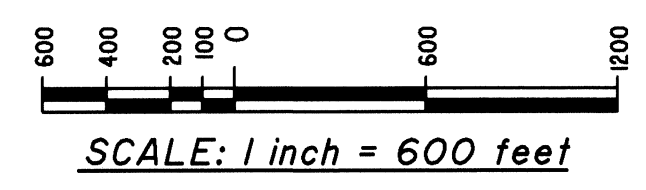
NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to mark the North and West lines of Section 30, T33S R2W, for timber harvesting by Weyerhaeuser. The subject lines were originally surveyed in 1879 by A.C. Eckelson for the U.S. General Land Office (GLO), under contract 328. In 1884, the lines were resurveyed by Rufus Moore, again for the GLO under contract 504, at which time all the corners were referenced. Then in 1958, the lines were once again resurveyed by Hans Thielsen for the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) under Group 406, at which time he re-monumented and referenced the corners.

During this survey, all the corners were found as monumented by the BLM in 1958. Additional references were added as described hereon. A brass flasher, stamped "LS-2069", was nailed to the scribed face of each new bearing tree (BT). The bearings and distances to each BT was taken to the center of the tree, referenced by a 60d nail in the right side center.

This survey was conducted using a "Leica TS06+" total station, obtaining a relative accuracy of over 1:10,000. The boundary lines were then marked with 1/2" x 6' white fiber glass rods, painted blazes and flagging.
