

## LOCATION:

Located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

## **PURPOSE:**

To survey and monument that tract described in Instrument Number 2017-022086 of the official Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

## **BASIS OF BEARINGS:**

Basis of bearing is the south line of Donation Land Claim per filed Survey Number 7902 at the Jackson County Surveyor's Office. Said bearing being N 89°51'58" West. PROCEDURE:

Utilizing Trimble R10 units and using static and real time kinematic methods and Trimble S6 robotic total station and reflecting prisms, I tie the monuments as shown. The center line intersection monument of Vista, Fork and West Fork Street was destroyed by construction and I hold tied monuments as shown to establish the intersection. The center line of Fork Street is determined by holding the above mentioned centerline intersection and the found monuments per filed survey numbers 16917 and 20783 as shown. Monuments set per filed survey number 20783, adjoining this survey's tract were tied and accepted. The 3/4 inch iron pipe, not of record, found at the angle point along the north line of the subject tract appears to be of the same age and appearance of those recovered and held by filed survey number 20783 along South Pioneer Street and was within acceptable limits of the computed position and was held as an original monument being set without record. South Pioneer Street center line monuments were tied and the northerly most tangent was resolved by bearing distance intersection with Fork Street, holding the distance from the 1888 Map of the City of Ashland for South pioneer and the bearing as derived from found monuments along Vista as shown. This results in a longer tangent distance along Fork than shown by record measurement between lost center line monuments but is also the result of the best available evidence.
