It was recently brought to my attention that a replacement survey for monuments set in the centerline of Atlantic Avenue was never filed with the Jackson County Surveyors Office by Hardey Engineering and Assoc., Inc. During the construction activities along Atlantic Avenue, certain centerline monuments were destroyed at several locations shown on Filed Survey No. 20728. Those monuments were replaced as follows:

Monuments numbered **149** (at Avenue "G"), **977** (at Falcon Street), and **1031** (at Avenue "H") have been previously replaced with a 5/8" x 24" iron rebar with 2" aluminum cap stamped "Hardey Eng. & Assoc."

These monuments have previously been referred to on Filed Survey Nos. 20852 and 21903, as well.

These monuments have been replaced in their record recovery positions prior to construction activities as noted on FS 20728 and no analysis of the correctness of their location has been made.
