

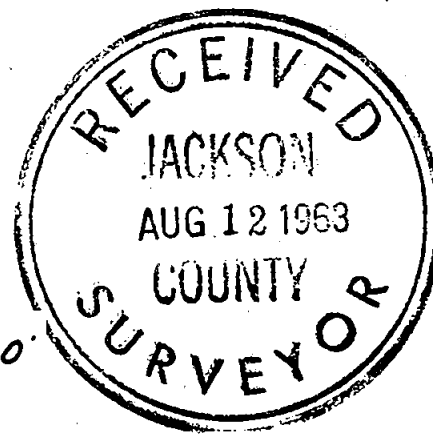
MAP

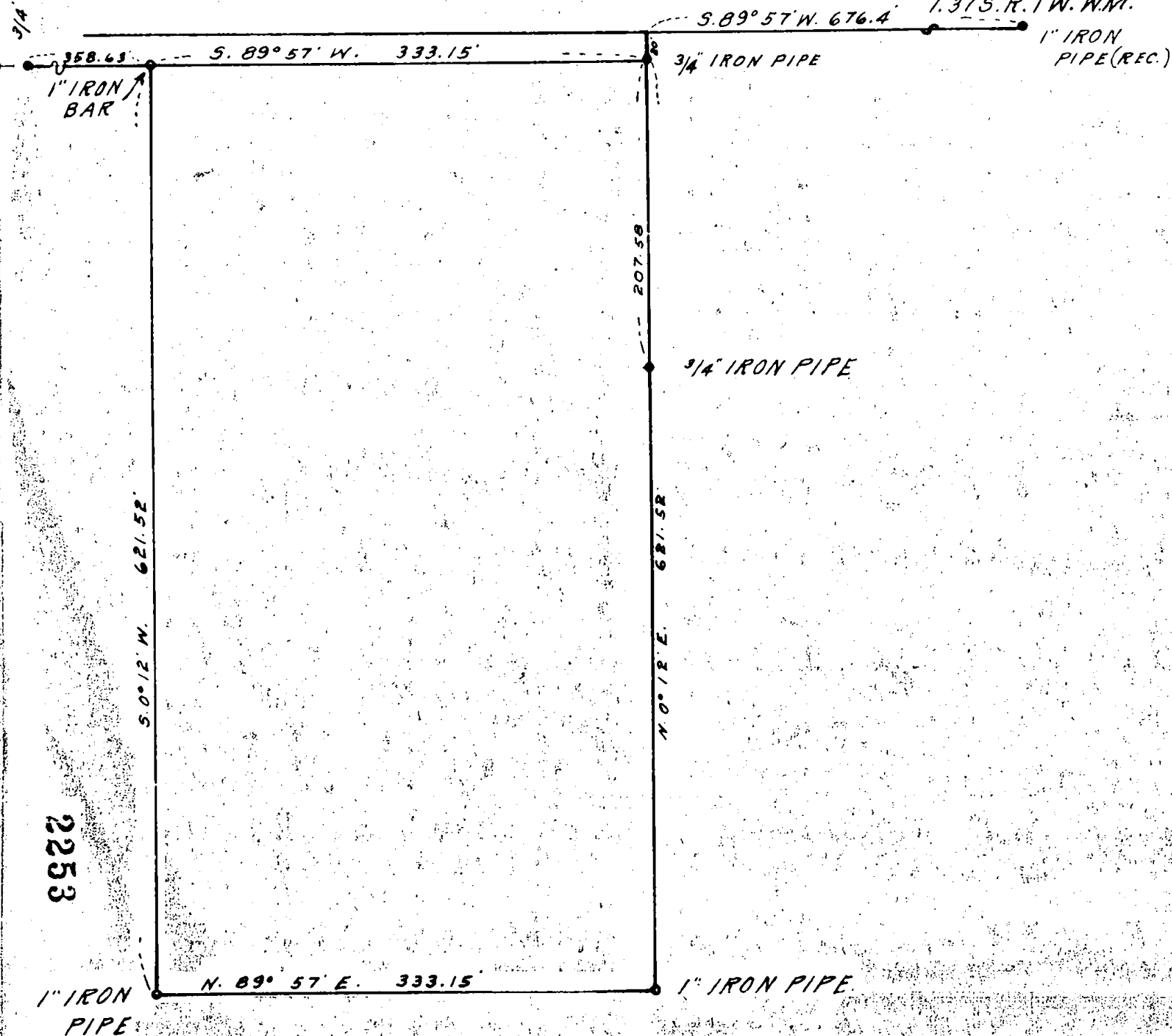

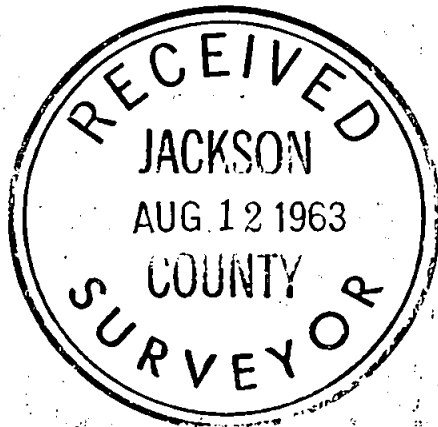
Survey narrative to comply with ORS 209.250
