

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Location:

In Lots 6, 7, and 8 of "Falling Leaf Subdivision" in the Northeast onequarter (1/4) of Section 10, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, City of Eagle Point, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose:

The purpose of this survey is to monument the property line adjustment of the lots originally described per instrument no. 2017-025871 O.R. and 2009-033781 O.R. as recorded in the Jackson County deed records, and approved by City of Eagle Point planning application number 18-14:BLA

Procedure:

The controlling elements for this project was the found monumentation per "Falling Leaf Subdivision" recorded as s/n 18452.

Centerline monuments along Falling Leaf Lane and monuments along the exterior boundary of lots 6, 7, and 8 of "Falling Leaf Subdivision" were found to fit extremely well. It was therefore decided that no proportion of record versus measured distances was required. Monuments that were found to be obliterated were set at record positions:

The new property line between the two lots being surveyed was decided by the clients and surveyed as shown hereon.

It should be noted that a previous Property Line Adjustment had been performed between lots 7 and 8 per s/n 19889. The adjusted line per s/n 19889 is now being re-adjusted through this Property Line Adjustment, and map of survey.


All monument ties and measurements were performed utilizing terrestrial methods and a Trimble S6 robotic total station.


