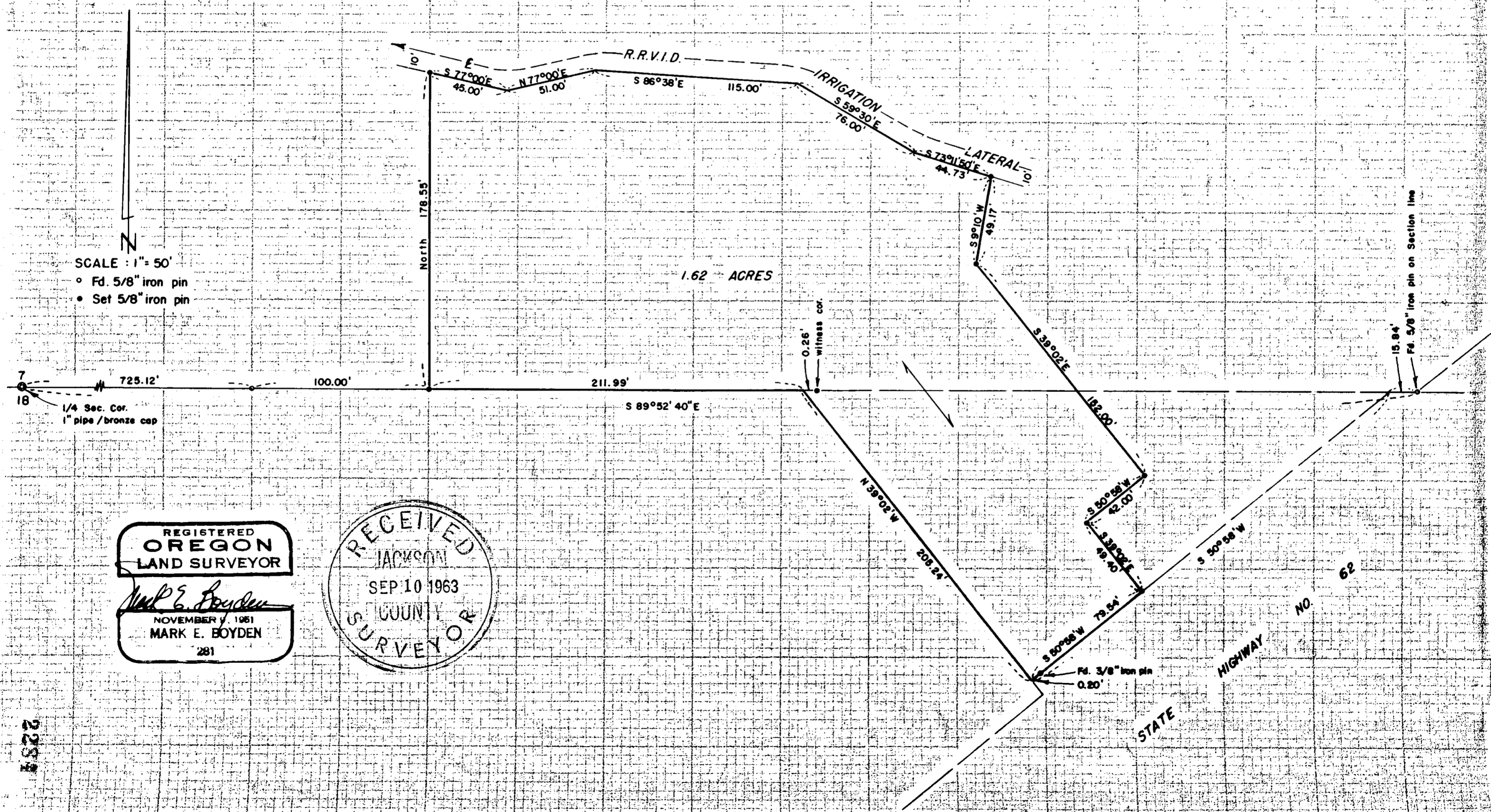

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

FOR: A. L. Nash  
2075 South Pacific Highway  
Medford, Oregon

LOCATION: Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 7,  
and the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4  
of Section 18, Township 37 South, Range 1 West,  
Willamette Meridian.

PURPOSE: To monument and describe a parcel within the  
Nash property for lease purposes.

PROCEDURE:

Found monuments previously set on Recorded Survey  
Nos. 1197, 1516 and 1977 for control of the North  
boundary of Section 18 and the Southwesterly boundary  
of that tract described in Volume 523, Page 490 of the  
Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

The pin set for the Most-Westerly corner of that  
tract surveyed for C. Ashpole, (Recorded Survey No. 1197)  
has been destroyed.

Monumented the parcel as shown, using for bearing  
control the meridian of solar origin determined on  
Recorded Survey No. 1977.
