

LOCATION:

Located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 32 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and recover or set monuments for that tract of land described as Parcel 10 in Instrument Number 94-22021, of the Official Records of Jackson Country, Oregon.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

The Basis of Bearings for this survey was determined by high precision GPS observations applied to the North line of Section 24 between the 2" lead filled reducer on a 1" iron pipe monumenting the section corner common to Sections 14/13/23/24 and the 3-1/4" brass cap monumenting the quarter corner common to Sections 13/24 resulting in a bearing of North 88°09'10" East.

PROCEDURE:

I recovered and tied monuments of record to control the northwest quarter of Section 24 as shown herein. I recovered and tied monuments of record as shown on Survey Number 16212 to control the right-of-way for Elk Creek Road. I held the monument at station 673+81.91 P.T. Right, and rotated the record alignment onto the monument at 681+89.29 P.C.C. Right. Dodes Creek Road was established by petition in 1934 with a 60 foot right-of-way as shown in County Journal Vol. 24, Page 149 and 233. Said 60' foot rightof-way is to be 30 feet on each side of centerline. I located the as-traveled centerline and offset 30 feet to create the easterly line of subject property. Per Instrument No. 94-22021, the southerly line of the subject property is that portion of the northwest 1/4 of the northwest 1/4 of said section lying north of the south 350 feet of said northwest 1/4 of the northwest 1/4. I held the recovered NW 1/16 corner set on Survey Number 11820 and was unable to locate the unrecorded N 1/16 shown on sheet 19 of 21 on Survey Number 15046 as DEA MONUMENT NO. 23/24-1756 so I held the computed position for the N 1/16 as shown herein.
