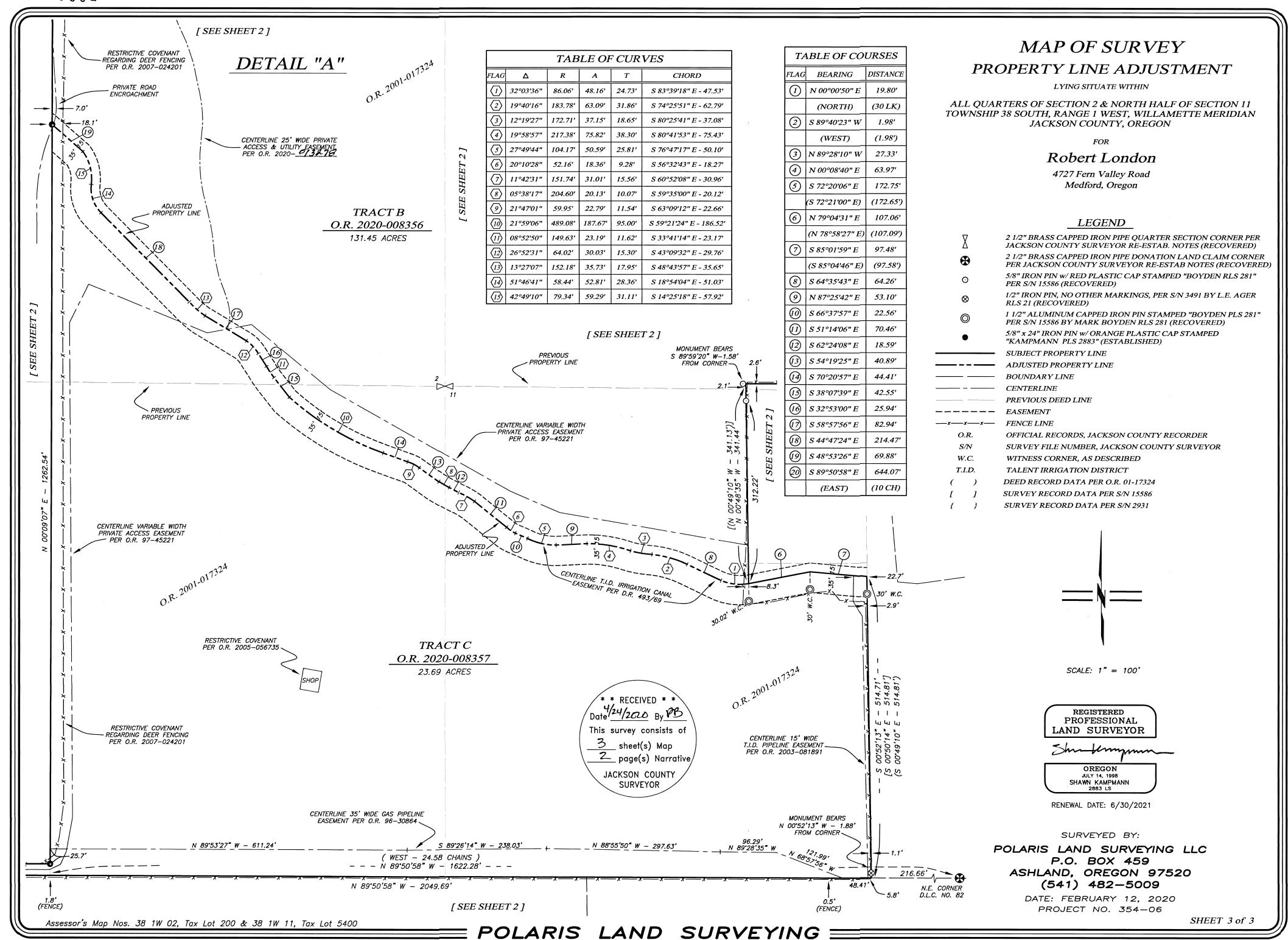

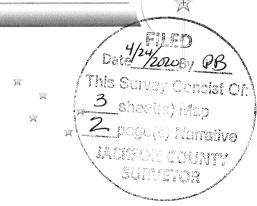

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

**SURVEY FOR:** 

Robert & Heath London

4727 Fern Valley Road Phoenix, Oregon 97530

LOCATION:

All Quarters of Section 2 and the North Half of Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

**PURPOSE:** 

To survey and monument a Property Line Adjustment between portions of those tracts of land described within Instrument No. 2001-017324 as approved per a Lot Legality claim by the Jackson County Planning Department in File No. 439-19-00037-SUB.

**PROCEDURE:** 

Utilizing a Leica GS-16 GNSS receiver operating in the ODOT/ ORGN network, in conjunction with a Leica TCRP 1200 robotic total station and ranging prisms, I survey the lands as shown hereon.

The parent tracts of the subject property were originally created by two U.S. GLO Land Grants for Patent Deed 2047 (1869) & Patent Deed 2544 (1870), referred on this map as Parcel 2 & Parcel 1 respectively. Parcel 1 was described as the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2. Parcel 2 was described as the East Half of the Southwest Quarter and the West Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 2. Also, Lots 2 & 3 in Section 11, both parcels lying within Township 38 South, Range 1 West. Both of these Patent Deeds were granted to Ebenezer W. Carver and by the beginning of 1933, Amelia B. Ferns owned the entirety of both the original, above referenced Carver Land Grants.

A history of exceptions from the above referenced Parcels are as follows: On January 7, 1933, the widow Amelia B. Ferns sold all of the above described property to Archie L. Ferns, Et Ux. in Warranty Deed Record

#### PROCEDURE (cont.)

Volume 193, Page 146, excepting therefrom, most of the West Half of Lot 2 and approximately three quarters of the West Half of the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 2. On March 7, 1957, Archie & Ida Ferns purchase a sliver of land approximately 28 feet wide and 589 feet long from Martin, Margaret and Henry Schnack in the most northeasterly corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 2 described in Volume 439, Page 66, and on the same day sell a tract of land to C.W and E.M. Lickess described in Volume 439, Page 68 of the Deed Records in Jackson County. On November 2, 1965 a Boundary Line Agreement was executed along the entire east line of the original Carver Land Grant's, described within Deed Record Volume 598. Page 213, leaving a sliver of land between the Agreement Line and the East Half of the East Half of Section 2 as now legally subdivided by this survey. Also, two tracts were conveyed out of easterly portion of Lot 3 in Section 11, and adjusted as described in Document No.'s 67-10610, 77-06913 as denoted on Survey No. 15586, in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.

In order to determine the aliquot fractions of Section 2, I recover and survey all the Section corners and Quarter corners in said Section 2, as well as the Donation Land Claim corners along the south lines of Lots 1, 2, 3 & 4 in Section 11 as denoted herein. Monuments were established at the Northwest, Center-North and Center-West One-Sixteenth corners, as well as two references established to perpetuate each of said corners. Monuments were also recovered and/or established at all angle points around the exterior tract boundaries, excepting the angle points along the adjusted property line for the centerline of the Talent Irrigation District canal.

BASIS OF BEARING: The Basis of Bearing for this survey is the East line of Donation Land

Claim No. 81, having a record plat bearing of North 00°23'40" East, as referenced on Survey No. 2931, 14812 & 21104, on file in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
