



POINT #8 WAS PREVIOUSLY TIED IN SAID SURVEY AND IS NOW REPLACED WITH A 1" COPPER PLUG MARKED "CITY OF MEDFORD"

EQUIPMENT USED TO PERFORM THIS SURVEY CONSISTED OF UTILIZING A TRIMBLE S6 ROBOTIC TOTAL STATION AND TSC3 DATA COLLECTOR. POINT NUMBERS 4 AND 7 FROM SURVEY 23023 WHERE FOUND TO BE DESTROYED DURING RAMP CONSTRUCTION AS WELL.
