## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH 209.250 O.R.S.

#### PURPOSE OF SURVEY:

TO PERPETUATE THE LOCATION OF FOUND MONUMENTS OF RECORD THAT MAY BE REMOVED, DESTROYED OR DISTURBED BY CONSTRUCTION PER O.R.S. 209.150.

#### PROCEDURE:

UTILIZING TRIMBLE R10 GNSS RECEIVERS AND A TRIMBLE S6 TOTAL STATION WITH RANGING PRISMS, AND HOLDING THE POSITION OF CONTROL POINT 1083812 PER S/N 22862 AS A GNSS BASE STATION, CONTROL AND MONUMENTS AS SHOWN HEREON WERE MEASURED WITH A COMBINATION OF 60-EPOCH RTK OBSERVATIONS AND CLOSED LOOP TRAVERSES.

CENTERLINES AS SHOWN HEREON ARE SHOWN TO REFERENCE MONUMENT LOCATIONS, AND DO NOT NECESSARILY COINCIDE WITH THE CENTER OF RIGHT-OF-WAY. THE EXCEPTIONS TO THIS ARE 25TH STREET AND KESTREL WAY, WHICH HAVE RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATIONS AS DETERMINED HEREON. THE SOUTH LINE OF KESTRAL MEADOWS SUBDIVISION, FILED AS SURVEY NO. 2011 WITH THE JACKSON COUNTY SURVEYOR, WAS HELD AS THE NORTH LINE OF KESTREL WAY, BEING NON-PARALLEL TO THE CENTERLINE OF SAID KESTREL WAY AS SHOWN HEREON, SAID ROAD HAVING BEEN DEDICATED PER FALCON MEADOWS SUBDIVISION, FILED AS SURVEY NO. 19388 WITH THE JACKSON
