

LOCATION:

Located in the Northeast and Southeast Quarters of Section 33 and the Southwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 33 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument that property line adjustment as approved by the Jackson County Planning Staff Report File #439-19-00074-sub.

BASIS OF BEARINGS:

Basis of Bearing is True North established by high precision GPS observations applied to the West line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing Trimble R10 receives and S6 Robotic Total Station and data collector, the section corners were tied as shown and noted. Record data per survey no. 9986 was calculated and used to subdivide the south west quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 34 and this was used to determine the south line of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 33 from the found monument per survey number 11633 at the southeast 1/16 to the calculated position at the south 1/16th between sections 33 and 34. A diligent search for right of way monuments along Highway 238 was made in the area of this survey and none found. Filed survey number 18351 also finds no monuments and determines the west right of way line of the highway by tying the highway center line. The center north 1/16 corner said Section 33 and the found monument at Station 1090+50 set per said survey were tied and the geometry of the west right of way line as shown on said survey was calculated and rotated to the north line of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter per this plat holding the record distance tie to the right of way per

said survey from the center north 1/16 corner. This fit well with the found right of way monument per said survey at Station 1090+50. The center line was offset from this geometry and the highway from Station 1090+50 south was calculated from the record data per Oregon State Highway Department Right of Way Map - Drawing # 5B-22-13. The highway painted center line was tied fronting the property shown on this plat and also fit with the calculated center line as described. This solution was held as the best available evidence and to perpetuate the previous survey resolution, as the deed ties described in volume 222, page 432 and volume 224, page 79 do not reflect the existing center line nor do they meet at the road stations as indicated. The new property lines were calculated from the parent tracts as described in Instrument Nos. 95-31791, 2007-018354 and 2007-041753 of the Official Records of Jackson County and corners set as shown.
