SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument Lot 14 of Christian Acres No. 3, described within Document No. 2019-004770 of the Official Records in Jackson County, Oregon. Narrative is a separate document from the Map of Survey

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing a Leica GS-16 GNSS receiver and Leica TS-16i robotic total station with ranging prisms, I survey and monument the lands as shown. Christian Acres No. 3 (Block 5) was recorded on January 27, 1966 in Volume 10, Page 29 of the Plat Records in Jackson County, Oregon, and was the final of three adjacent phases. In that era, many subdivisions were monumented prior to construction of street and utility improvements and numerous monuments were destroyed in this area and very few lot corners remain. Only one monument was recovered along the entire right of-way of 4th Street that wasn't badly damaged and only the Initial Point for this subdivision was recovered of all the exterior boundary corners. The east line of 40 foot wide West Street, as platted on Christian Acres No. 1, is denoted as bounding the east line of Donation Land Claim No. 63 until intersecting Wagner Creek Road, and continuing south to the Southwest Corner of D.L.C. No. 64 which I tie for this survey. Oddly, monuments recovered along the west line of West Street are not parallel with said D.L.C. line and found to be between 42.5 and 41.5 feet off of said D.L.C. line. I show the dedicated 40' right-of-way and the remainder strip between the right-of-way and the monumented subdivision lots adjacent to West Street to highlight the survey anomaly. The west line of Christian Acres, Block's 1 through 5 and Partition Plat No. P-71-2000 was determined by holding the 1/2" iron pipes established on the 1950 Christian Acres No. 1 and 1953 Survey No. 886, both by L.E. Ager. Plat record was utilized for the west line of Christian Acres No. 3, holding the 2.00 foot witness corner from Survey No. 19404. The west line of West Street was determined by holding the 2" iron pipe at the Initial Point of said Block 5 and the crimped top iron pipe at the northeast corner of Lot 11, Block 3, Christian Acres. As an aside, crimp top pipes were a unique, definitive trademark of L.E. Ager which I trust to be original to that era. I proportion the lots in Block 5 along the north and east lines, as well as along the south line of Lots 8, 13, 14, 15 & 16 to the Initial Point. This resolution fit very well against the plat record and was held for this survey.

BASIS OF BEARING: The Basis of Bearing for this survey is the East line of Christian Acres No. 3, having a record plat bearing of South 00°18'00" East, as referenced on

Survey No. 2980, on file in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
