PROCEDURE: Equipment/Software utilized: Trimble TSC7 data collector with Trimble Access Software; Trimble RIO GN55 equipment; Trimble 57 robotic instrument; Trimble Business Center and Trimble Terramodel. Records utilized: Instrument Number 2021-013694 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon; plat recorded as Partition Plat Number P-35-2004 of the Records of Jackson County, Oregon, Volume 15 at Page 35; Corner reestablishment notes and Survey Number 866 as filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.
