

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

PURPOSE: Pursuant to Client's request and direction, perform a boundary survey, recover existing monuments, establish monuments at boundary corners as needed, and file a Map of Survey in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.

PROCEDURE: Equipment/Software utilized: Trimble TSC7 data collector with Trimble Access Software; Trimble RIO GNSS equipment; Trimble S7 robotic instrument; Trimble Business Center and Trimble Terramodel. Records utilized: Instrument Numbered 2013-041650, of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon; Corner re- establishment notes and Survey's Numbered 8872, 10167 and 11763, all as filed in the office of the Jackson County Surveyor.

Linear unit (horizontal) is International Foot (ift); Linear unit (vertical) is U.S. Survey Foot (usft); Vertical datum is the North American Datum of 1988 (NAVD88); Geodetic Information: Datum is the North American Datum (NAD) of 1983 (2011) Epoch 2010.00; System is the Oregon Coordinate Reference System; Zone is the Grants Pass-Ashland (Refer to ORS, Chapter 93.312(c)). All bearings and distances shown hereon are projected (grid) values based on the projection definition herein and above. This projection was utilized in order to minimize the difference between projected (grid) distances and horizontal (ground) distances at the topographic surface within the design area of this coordinate system. The basis of bearings is Geodetic North. Note that the grid bearings depicted do not equal géodetic bearings due to meridian convergence.

The subject tract of land is described per said instrument Number 2013-041650, which said Survey Number 11763 matches said instrument. Exterior boundaries of the subject tract were resolved utilizing said instrument, said Survey Number 11763 and found monuments as follows: Held One-quarter common to Sections 5 and 8, and the monument set per said Survey Number 10167 to resolve the southerly boundary; Held said monument per Survey Number 10167 and a found damaged monument per Survey Number 11763 (top of which was bent over and set a new monument it the point where the straight portion of said monument was vertically in the ground) to resolve the easterly boundary; Held said set monument, found monuments per Survey Number 8872 and 11763 to resolve the westerly boundary lines; Held said monument per Survey Number 8872 (marking the Center-South One-sixteenth corner of Section 5) and aforesaid One-quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 8 to resolve the westerly boundary.

Established the monument at the northeast corner and marked boundary lines on April 7, 2022.
